The Maine Trapshooting Association is proud to dedicate the 2026 Maine State Championships to Thomas “Gramps” Hartranft in recognition of his longstanding and significant contributions to the sport of trapshooting in Maine.

Originally a skeet shooter, Tom began shooting trap in 1996 and has been very competitive at 52 ranges across 17 states, with additional practice locations from Nova Scotia to Arizona. Over his career, he has registered 28,400 singles, 20,100 handicap, and 22,400 doubles targets. He has served the Association as President and currently as Treasurer. He led the group to rewrite the association’s By-laws in 2019. At his home range, Norway–Paris Fish and Game Association, he has consistently supported events through data entry and volunteer coordination.

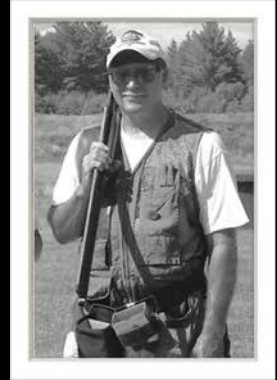
Tom has played a key role in planning the Maine State Shoot, including coordinating youth participation, managing camping assignments, soliciting our shoot labor, and promoting trapshooting throughout the state. His leadership and insight have had a lasting impact on the Association. Under his direction, the Maine State Hall of Fame, identified and honored exemplary shooters in Maine’s history. This is housed upstairs at the Scarborough Fish and Game clubhouse.

An accomplished competitor, and shooter who doesn’t like to lose, Tom has earned numerous state titles, including the State Doubles Championship in 2018, High All Around in 2022, runner-up High All Around in 2024, and Resident High Over All in 2024. Through his dedication, service, and sportsmanship, Tom has built strong relationships across the trapshooting community and exemplifies a deep commitment to Maine Trapshooting.

A special note from the Morrison family:

*Trapshooting is not just about your scores; it is about the friends you make along the way. Over the past six years, Tom has offered advice, shared some amazing and funny stories, written some great poems, and made us laugh. We consider it a privilege to count him as a friend and mentor, and we are thankful for all the memories we continue to make.*

## GENERAL INFORMATION

*It is the shooter's responsibility to be informed of the contents of this program and rules governing ATA sanctioned shoots. All shooters must be classified before making their entries. On Championship Singles, target fees for all resident sub juniors and juniors will be reduced by 50%, provided no monies are played.*

1. Management reserves the right to reject any entry and make changes to the program.
2. Anyone violating any of the rules may be disqualified and will not share in any prize money or trophies.
3. Shooters and spectators assume all responsibilities for any and all accidents.
4. The MTA president, State ATA Delegate, and designees, will act as a Committee to rule on all disputes.
5. White Flyer Orange Top Pitch Targets will be thrown.
6. All banks will be drawn once a day so that all events that day will be shot on that rotation. Event targets will be shot on three banks of two traps each. The "Quick 50" format will be used at the discretion of shoot management and only if necessary.
7. The practice field will be open at 4pm on Wednesday, July 8th and during the tournament from 8am to 4pm. Practice rounds are priced at the Scarborough club's member rate of \$7.00 per round of 25.
8. Trophies will be available for pick up each day and will not be mailed.
9. Cell phones and pagers are not allowed on the line.

10. Campsites and RV Parking are available. Reservations are on a first come first serve basis. Sites include water but no power. Camper access is available July 6th to 13th. Gate codes will be provided. **Contact Tom Hartranft at 864-350-3781 or thartr4941@aol.com for reservations.**

11. It is the shooter's responsibility to verify their scores on both the scoresheets and the scoreboard. Once purses and options are figured they will not be changed. However, scores will be corrected for record purposes.

12. Strict adherence to ATA and SF&G club rules regarding alcohol, drugs and eye and ear protection will be observed.

13. Ties in singles and doubles on Thursday and Friday will be carried over by sub event to the next like event. Ties in Handicap will be shot off.

14. Special category shooters must declare their category at the time of classification and verify it is indicated on their receipt. Saturday's single classification will determine the High All Around Class.

15. To pre-squad please log on to [www.SOSclays.com](http://www.SOSclays.com). Pre-Squad opens on June 3rd and closes on July 5th.

16. There will be a meeting of the MTA membership Sunday to begin no latter than 11:45 for the purpose of electing the ATA delegate and Alternate(s). All resident Maine shooters are encouraged to attend.

17. The Scarborough club has ammo for sale to shooters up to the amount they are shooting in this tournament. The cost is \$10.00 per box on a first come first serve basis, until stock is depleted.

18. Classification will be available Wednesday evening (July 8th) from 4:30pm to 6pm.

## Classification

Classification will be based on the last 600 targets, total average or known ability, whichever is higher. Robert Harris, Jr., ATA Delegate, is chairman of the Classification Committee. It is the shooter's responsibility to see that their ATA card is correct and up to date. Falsified cards will result in disqualification. It is the shooters responsibility to make category declaration when classified.

AA -----	97% and over
A -----	94% and under 97%

AA -----	93% and over

### Penalty

Shooters must have at least 600 singles, 500 handicap and 400 doubles for 2024 and 2025 target years combines to avoid penalty classification.

### Handicap

Adult male, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran and Veteran shooters not meeting target requirements will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yard age, subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum. Ladies (1&2), Sub Juniors and Juniors will follow the same rules except the minimum penalty will be 21 yards. There will be no penalty yardage to shooters who are 70 years or older. Any shooter may elect to shoot for targets only and be exempted from penalty yardage. However; said person will not be allowed to play purses or options and forfeits all rights to added monies and trophies.
