ENTRY TICKETS

Entry tickets for Thursday's Events 1, 2 & 3 will be available early on
Thursday morning.

Entry tickets for Friday, Saturday and Sunday's Events 4 - 10 will
be available on Thursday from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM

Entries taken on Saturday morning will be limited to the
Singles Event 7.

Entries for Doubles Event 8 and Handicap Event 9 will be
taken after the 2nd 100 targets have started on Saturday.

BANK SYSTEM - 6 BANKS ON (2) ADJACENT TRAPS

The shoot will be conducted using a six bank system on two
adjacent trap fields for the Singles and Handicap Events. The
number of Doubles traps will be determined by the number
of entries in that Event.

BRING TWO BOXES OF SHELLS TO THE LINE

Please bring two full boxes of shells to the line on each trap so no
time is wasted going back to the gun rack. This will help avoiding
shooting ten targets per station. This will help provide sufficient
daylight at the days end. Please help those shooters who will
be shooting at the end of the day have the same opportunity
as those shooting earlier in the day.

WHAT BANK DOES MY SQUAD SHOOT ON

Banks will be determined by random draw before each
100 target Event for Singles and Handicap. Grid sheets
will be posted at the Cashier's Office and at the scoreboard
indicating what Bank your Squad will be shooting on.
In addition the Banks and Squads will be posted and updated
on the outdoor Trap Field Board.

MATA GENERAL INFO (CON'T)

RESIDENT JUNIOR & SUB JUNIOR TARGET FEES

Any resident Junior or Sub Junior, who has at least 300 singles targets for the current year, will pay \$42.00 for targets in Saturday's 200 Singles Event, if no purses or options are played.

STATE SHOOT REFEREES

MATA Officers will act as official line referees and act as the committee to rule on any disputes and reserves the right to refuse any entry, to change or cancel, all or any part of the program or adjust traps at any time, as circumstances require.

MATA MEMBERSHIP

Per ATA rules, all Massachusetts resident shooters are required to be members of the MATA.

TROPHIES

Only MATA members are eligible for resident trophies & resident added money.
Nonresident shooters are eligible for nonresident trophies.
All shooters are eligible for open trophies & open money.
All Around class trophies are based on the shooter's Saturday singles class. Shooters are eligible for only one trophy per event.

HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARD

The Trapshooting Hall of Fame maintains a museum and provides a research library for the history of the sport. It also awards college scholarships and conducts a youth program to promote the future of trapshooting. Half of the entry for this award is donated to the Hall of Fame. We encourage you to participate and support its various activities.

ATA REFUND

The 2017 ATA refund for dues and daily fees for Massachusetts amounted to \$2,507.00.

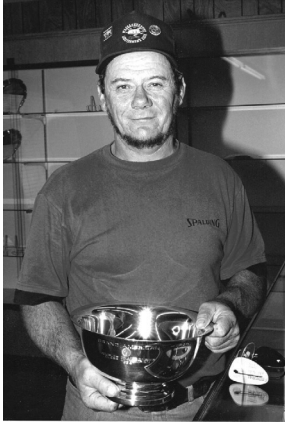
AUDITOR'S REPORT

CLASSIFICATION

(Plus Known Ability)

Classification will be based on the last 700 targets, or total average, whichever is greater. Our ATA State Delegate is chairman of the Classification Committee. It is the shooter's responsibility to keep their card up to date. If it is NOT, shooters must shoot Class AA. It is the shooter's responsibility to make sure he or she is properly classified. Errors in classification could result in disqualification. All Massachusetts residents must show their current MATA Cards to shoot in any Event Please have both your ATA and MATA cards with you when classifying.

PENALTY

Shooters must have at least 700 singles, 700 handicap and 300 doubles for the current and previous year combined or they will shoot penalty. Targets shot on Friday may be counted toward minimum requirements for classifications on Saturdays and Sunday Events.

Adult male shooters will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yardage, subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum. Ladies, Juniors, Sub Juniors, and Veterans will follow the same rules except the minimum penalty yardage will be 21 yards. Ladies, Juniors, Sub Juniors and Veterans may elect to shoot for targets only and be exempted from the penalty yardage, but may not compete for their own special category trophies. There will be no penalty yardage assigned to Senior Veterans. Adult males may shoot their yardage, but are not eligible for prizes or money.

FAILURE TO FIRE

- Two (2) failure to fires are allowed and shot over per sub event
- Targets thrown “on time”, within legal limits and not voluntarily shot at by the contestant are NOT allowable Failures to Fire
- Failures to Fire are usually the result of mechanical (gun) or ammunition problems
- The Scorekeeper is required to mark the scoresheet (“F1”, “F2”, etc.) when failures occur
- For HAA and HOA shoot offs – one (1) Failure is allowed in each of the 3 disciplines
- During Doubles, when the single operation of the trigger results in the shooter being unable to fire at the second target (the gun fires both shells at once or “machine gunning” occurs) it is considered a Failure to Fire on the second target.

DOUBLES FAILURE TO FIRE

FIRST & SECOND FAILURE TO FIRE -

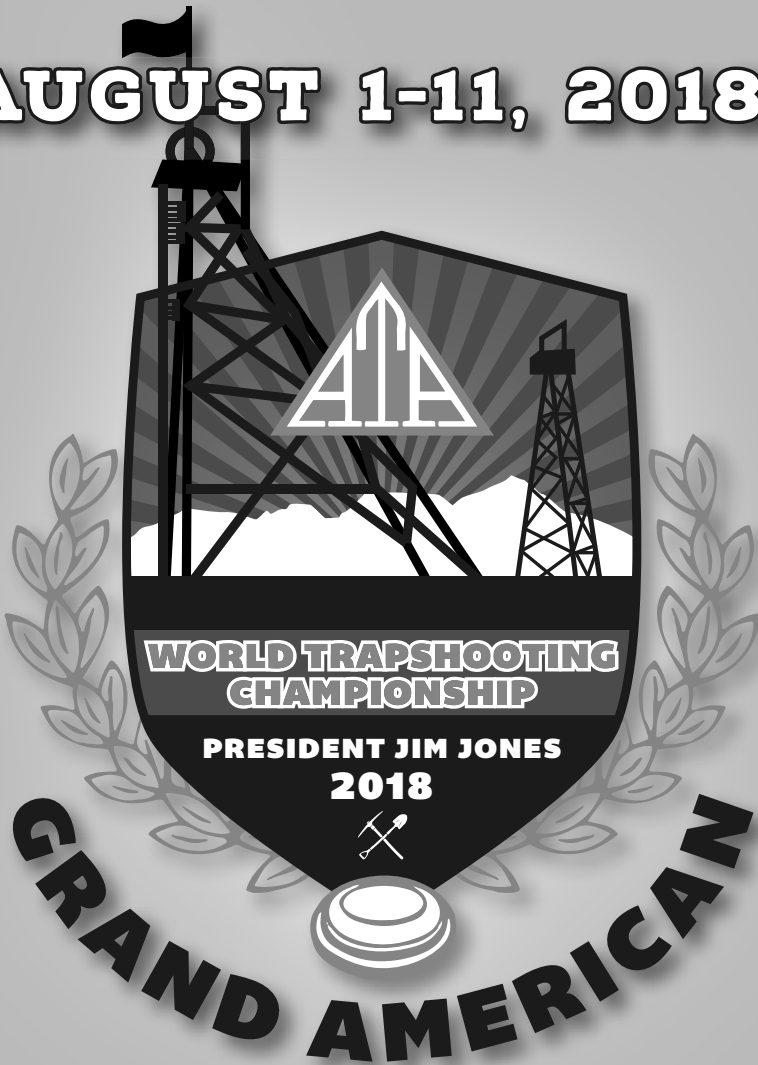
- If the Failure is on the FIRST SHOT and the shooter does not shoot at the second target –
Nothing is established for either target, shoot the pair over
- If the Failure is on the FIRST SHOT and the shooter fires at the second target –
Second target is established as shot – Shoot the pair over to establish first target only
- If the Failure is on the SECOND SHOT –
First target is established as shot - Shoot the pair over to establish second target only

ALL ADDITIONAL (3 OR MORE) FAILURES TO FIRE –

- If the Failure is on the FIRST SHOT and the SECOND TARGET IS SHOT –
First target is LOST, second is scored as shot
- If the Failure is on the FIRST SHOT and the SECOND TARGET IS NOT SHOT –
First target is LOST, pair is shot over to establish second target only
- If the Failure is on the SECOND SHOT and the FIRST TARGET IS SHOT –
First target is scored as shot, second target is LOST
