Notice

All Oregon State Amateur Trapshooting Association members of record are hereby notified of the Annual Meeting to be held June 3, 2017 at 8:00 AM at Portland Gun Club. Please make every effort to attend this meeting because this is ***your*** Association. Your ATA Delegate and 1st and 2nd Alternates will be nominated and elected at this meeting.

The terms of service of Mike Mann, Mike Warn, and Daro Handy expire in 2018. Individuals who want to serve on the Board of Directors should make themselves and their qualifications known to the Nominating Committee Chair—Dexter Tourville (541-878-2608) and request that their name be placed in consideration for one of the vacant positions.

Each year the Amateur Trapshooting Association refunds to the OSATA a percentage of the daily fees collected and a percentage of memberships paid in from the State of Oregon.

The 2018 refund to the OSATA was \$807.00.

\$2,250.00 in added money and \$1700.00 in additional trophies is available in this Oregon State ATA Championship.

All of the added money comes from Sponsorship donations and all sponsors are acknowledged throughout this program.

Shooter's Responsibility

Display **ALL** your average cards at the Handicap Table immediately upon arrival. Shooters are required to have both their 16 yard and doubles averages computed for use by the Handicap Committee. Computer generated average cards are encouraged and accepted.

PENALTY: At this shoot, class and yardage penalty will apply to shooters who do not have 500 16-yard and handicap **targets in the current and previous year**. Class B and 23 yards will be assigned. 300 targets are required in doubles in the **current and previous year**, or shoot Class B. Targets shot in PITA registered competition may be counted to avoid penalty classification. Be sure your classification and handicap yardage are marked plainly on your entry form before you leave the table. It is your responsibility to know the rules. You are subject to penalties for shooting the wrong classification or on the wrong yardage even if your card is so marked. It shall be the shooter's responsibility to inform the Handicap Committee as to their eligibility for special category (Lady-1, Lady-II, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior Gold, Junior and Sub-Junior) to be indicated on their entry form. Without such a declaration at the time of entry, the shooter will not be allowed to compete for the applicable special category trophies. **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this rule will be allowed.

If possible, please enter all events you plan to shoot at the time of your initial entry. This will save a considerable amount of time and make things more pleasant for all shooters. This shoot is available for pre-squadding at www.presquad.com. There is no charge for this service.

No counter checks or second party checks will be accepted by the Cashier. Checks will be accepted for the amount of shooting fees only, no exceptions. All entries must be made in US funds payable to **Portland Gun Club**.

RULES: By entering the competition, every contestant agrees to accept all official decisions and to abide by the ATA rules. Members are strongly encouraged to know the ATA rules and abide by them, both for their own benefit and for the benefit of other shooters.

Class winners and ties will be advanced one class for the next like event.

THREE MINUTE WAIT: Be ready to shoot when your squad is called. No shooter will be called on the speaker. Your squad will be allowed a wait of three minutes for you to take your place.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR SCORE AFTER FIRING AT EACH 5 TARGETS: According to ATA rules, the score keeper must keep the score sheet in plain view of the shooters at all times. If shooters insist on this, many problems may be avoided. The referee will total the score after each 25 targets and the squad leader will initial the score sheet before leaving the trap. Errors made in totaling will be corrected when discovered. Any target other than clearly marked dead, shall be lost.

SHORT SQUADS: Short squads will be avoided when possible.

RELOADS: Reloads will be permitted at this tournament.

SAFETY: All persons including competitors, referees and trap personnel must wear eye and hearing protection while on the trap field. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.

GUN BREAKDOWN: In case of gun breakdown, a shooter will be allowed fifteen (15) minutes for gun repair or replacement.

TARGET SETTING: Targets will be set each morning and checked between events by the target setting committee according to ATA rules. Re-setting of targets will only be done by OSATA officials or designated line judges.

SHOOT-OFFS: Shoot-offs will be held following the last event of the day in the order they were shot. The first call will be announced 15 minutes after the last squad in the last daily event has finished shooting. The second call will be 5 minutes later. Any shooter who does not report to their assigned trap within three minutes after the second call will be disqualified. Ties will be shot off in all events except Events 1 and 3 unless all shooters involved in the tie agree to carry-over or other resolution of the tie. Events 1 and 3 will be carried over to events 4 and 7.

IRS REGULATIONS: IRS regulations require a Social Security number for payout values of \$600.00 or greater.

PAYOUTS: The shooter must check the payout sheets before the start of the last event. Problems must be resolved prior to the end of the shoot or the results will stand as posted. Payouts not collected at the shoot will be mailed within 10 days of the end of the shoot.

REFUNDS: No entry fee, purses, or options will be refunded after an event has started.

TROPHIES:

1 Should you win or tie for class in any singles or doubles event, or earn yardage in any handicap event, it shall be your duty to report to the Handicap Table and have your classification reviewed or yardage punched. Any shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason shall be considered to be notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin board.

2 Any shooter failing to carry out rule # 1, or who shoots in a class or on a yardage marked higher or lower than that which is marked on his card, will be subject to penalty and will not be eligible to share in any money division or trophy whatsoever.

3 Only one (1) ATA trophy shall be awarded to any one (1) person in any separate event.

4 At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded, shooters may declare only one (1) Special Category (i.e. Lady 1, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran or Senior Veteran).

5 Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may shoot-off for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the Championship trophy shoot-off and has declared a Special Category at classification, the shooter will fall back to his/her declared Category.

6 Any shooter who has declared a Special Category at Classification and whose score qualifies him/her for any trophy in his/her declared Category will compete for the Category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group.

7 Any Category shooter whose score doesn't qualify for a trophy in his/her Category may compete for place, class or yardage group. There will be no exceptions to this Rule.

8 Trophy ties in Events 1 and 3 will be carried over to the next like event by sub-event.

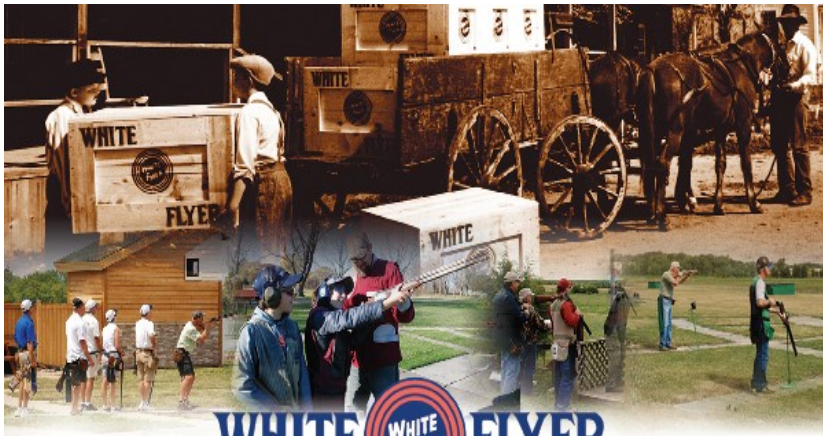
Event #2, The President's Handicap, has historically honored the current President of the Oregon State Amateur Trapshooting Association.

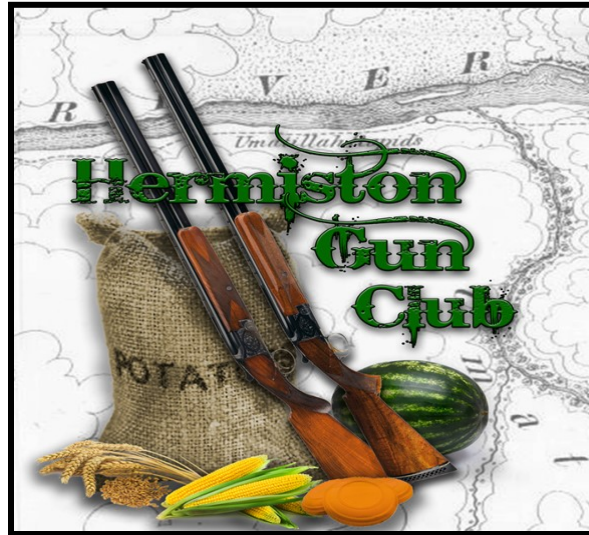

Mervin W. Swearingen
Pendleton, June 13, 1935-January 10, 2015

Father, Grandfather, Brother, Farmer, Husband, Trapshooter, Friend

Mervin passed away at his home January 10, 2015, at age 79. He was born in Craig, Nebraska, on June 13, 1935, to Elmer and Ethel Bergstadt Swearingen. The family came to the Helix area to farm for the Stockman Ranch when Merv was 3 years old. He graduated from Helix High School in 1953 (a class of five with Betty Christopher being the only girl), participating in school sports and activities, which led him to become a lifetime Grizzly fan and volunteer.

On April 17, 1955, he married Betty Elaine Christopher at Peace Lutheran Church in Pendleton, Oregon. They were married for over 50 years, raising their family and farming in the Pendleton and Helix area. Betty preceded Merv in death in 2008.

After graduating high school, Mervin attended Eastern Oregon State College in La Grande. He served in the Oregon Army National Guard for 10 years. He was very active in the local community, serving as a former board member for Pendleton Grain Growers, and as a member of the Oregon Wheat League, Umatilla County Historical Society and BPOE Elks. Merv was also a founding director of the Helix Rodeo, providing funding for Helix High School scholarships.

Mervin was an active volunteer with the Pendleton Round-Up for 50 years, and was honored to be the co-grand marshal of the Pendleton Round-Up's Westward Ho! Parade in 2009 with his brother Wayne.

One of his greatest loves was trap shooting. Being one of the Northwest's best shooters, he with his wife Betty traveled to trap shoots across the country bringing home numerous trophies, buckles and awards. Mervin was instrumental in starting the Oregon State ATA Hall of Fame and sponsored the Swearingen High Average Awards for the best Oregon trap shooters annually. He was inducted into the Oregon State ATA Hall of Fame in 1992.

Mervin will certainly be missed by not forgotten!

The OSATA has committed to keep Merv's contributions to the OSATA and his shooting legacy alive through the annual recognition of the "Swearingen High Average Awards".

The late Merv Swearingen had awarded honors to those shooters with the highest averages for the previous shooting year. These awards are given to the five high Singles, Handicap, and Doubles Shooters. To qualify, the shooter must have shot and registered a minimum of 1,500 Singles, 1,200 Handicap, and 800 Doubles ATA targets. The Swearingen All Star Team shall consist of the five highest average shooters and the average leaders in five special categories: Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior, and Sub-Junior. After Merv's passing, the OSATA Board of Directors has elected to continue presentation of the Swearingen awards indefinitely.
