RULES AND REGULATIONS

NTA Trophies are open to residents of the Nebraska Western Zone only. The Nebraska Western Zone is defined as that part of the state West of Highway 83, except in Lincoln and Red Willow Counties, which are all in the Western Zone. Club Trophies are open to everyone.

AA - 97% & over
A - 94% to 97%
B - 91% to 94%
C - 88% to 91%
D - under 88%

Doubles

AA - 93% & over
A - 89% to 93%
B - 85% to 89%
C - 78% to 85%
D - under 78%

Added money is open to anyone regardless of residence.

Classification by ATA Rules

The management reserves the right to refuse entry or disqualify anyone who might interfere with the harmony of this shoot. Management decisions are final. The "Club" is not responsible for any loss or accident. A contestant may use his or her own shells and reloads will be permitted for this shoot.

Penalty Yardage and Classification for this shoot

Penalty yardage and class will be assigned when a shooter has not met the minimum requirement, or the classification committee determines the average does not reflect the shooters true ability.
