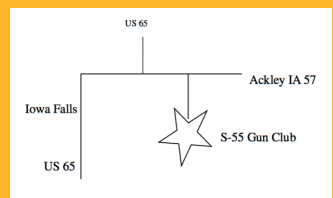

- 105 ICCAC Academic All-Region honors earned by Ellsworth student athletes



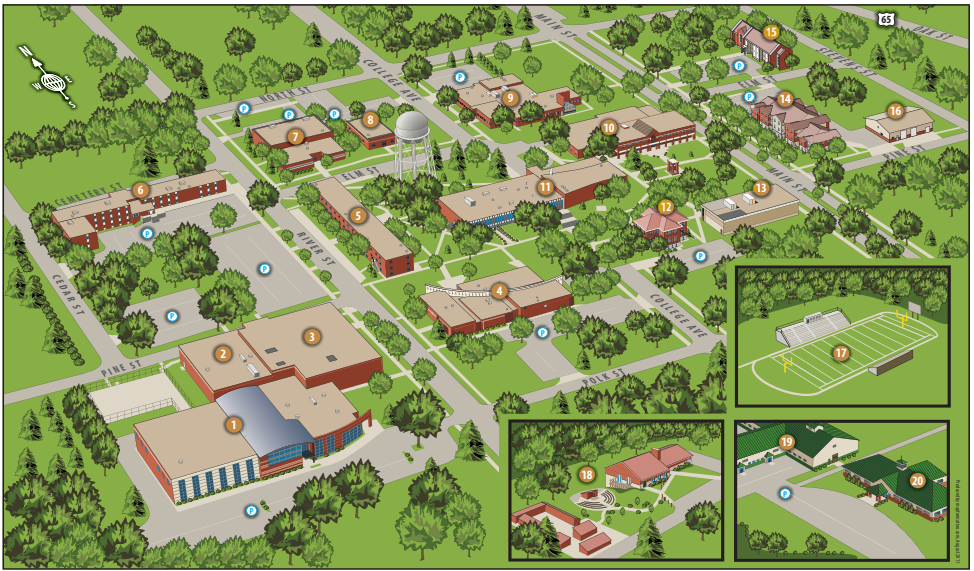
