Trophies distributed after all shoot offs are complete. A trophy may be mailed if a trophy is unavailable on the day of the shoot.

\*\*\*Juniors may shoot reduced price targets if playing no purses or options in any event. If money is played in any event, Junior and Sub-Junior must pay full price for targets in ALL events.\*\*\*

Everyone may shoot for purse and options in their proper class or yardage group. No purse or option monies may be entered or withdrawn after the first squad completes its first sub-event.
