PENALTIES: Shooters who do not have a total of 500 Singles/500 Handicap/250 Doubles targets registered in the current target year will be advanced 1 class/yardage group at the discretion of the Directors.

No prizes may be taken by winners until signed for with the Awards Committee. All shells for this shoot must be picked up the day of the shoot.





One of her most amazing accomplishments came in 1990 when she became the first woman to break 100 straight doubles at the Grand American Trap Shoot, where she scored a 120 x 120 in a shoot off to capture the ATA Championship. 
