1. Classification/squadding and practice opens at 8:00 AM each day. Events start at 9:30 AM each day.
2. Entries for the first event each day must be cashiered no later than 30 minutes after the event starts.
3. **Targets may be cross-registered with PITA. PITA Daily Fees: PITA \$4, AZ \$2.**
4. Juniors and Sub Juniors will be offered \$18/100 entry fees courtesy of 2 Lazy 2 and the ASTA.

Tournament Rules

1. Arizona Residents must be current ASTA members at the time of classification/entry.
2. Daily Fees will be charged once per day per participant. ATA \$3 — ASTA \$2.
3. ATA Rules govern all events. By entering an event, shooters agree to abide by all ATA Rules and Regulations and to accept all official decisions.
4. Classification will be in accordance with current ATA Rules and based on the shooter's official ATA registered averages and known ability. Please have your average card up to date to ensure proper classification. There will be five classes, five categories and four yardage groups. There will be no class or yardage penalties.
5. If you wish to declare a special category, Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior or Sub-junior, **it must be done at the time of classification/entry**. Dual category shooters may only declare one category. A special category shooter whose event score qualifies for a *special category trophy is not eligible for class or yardage trophies*. A special category shooter whose event score *does not qualify for a special category trophy is eligible for class or yardage group trophies*. Changes will not be made after the shooter's first shot has been fired unless it is due to a classification error. Please check your cashier's sheet to make sure you have been classified correctly.
6. Ties will be carried over to the next like event. Handicap ties will be shot off if any of the involved shooters has a yardage change. There will be no class advancements for this shoot, however, any shooter's class/score is subject to review. Any remaining ties will be shot off Sunday following the handicap.
7. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on the practice trap due to missed squads or gun repairs. Make-ups must be completed immediately following the event.
8. Any shooter who has not received monies won during this tournament, agrees that payment in the form of a check will be mailed to the address indicated by ATA records. When mailed, neither 2 Lazy 2, the BACTC or the ASTA will be liable for any checks lost, stolen, unclaimed, undelivered or otherwise not received by the shooter. Checks not cashed within 90 days will become void.
9. The consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs prior to shooting in any event, including shoot-offs and practice, is not allowed and will result in disqualification of any scores shot.
10. Management reserves the right to change/modify the shoot program at their discretion if necessary.

This certifies the Ben Avery Clay Target Center and 2 Lazy 2 has been authorized to hold a registered tournament January 15-19, 2020.

2020 HALL OF FAME

The Williams become our 53rd inductee and the first married couple inducted into the Arizona Trapshooting Hall of Fame.

Even though Gerry and Kristi both grew up in Ellensburg, WA, Kristi was born there and Gerry moved there when he was six months old, and both were involved in trapshooting at young ages, because they are seven years apart in age, their paths didn't cross until 1999.

Gerry started shooting around age 8 or 9 when his Dad used to "hand throw" targets for him and his brother. They got interested in trapshooting and went out to the Ellensburg F&S club where Gerry would load birds, shovel snow, mow the grass among other things and in return, get to shoot a round or two. His first gun was a Winchester Model 37 20 ga. single with hammer. While he didn't hit many targets, he was able to hit enough for the "light to come on" and fell in love with trapshooting. He registered his first trap targets as a Sub Junior in 1961 and won a few trophies over the next few years. He was fortunate to win some of those in Reno and Vegas – gold coins which he still has today! He won his first Grand American trophies in 1964 as a Junior and was named to the 1965 Junior 2nd All American team – the first of 12 All-American team placements.

In 1969 while serving in the Coast Guard and home on leave, he captured his first Washington State Singles crown. In August of that year and back on a boat in Alaska, he received permission to attend the Grand to participate in the Champion of Champions Event. During the Vandalia Handicap he advanced to the 27 yd line and remains at that yardage today. Gerry shot a Ljutic for many years and now shoots a Silver Seitz for singles and handicap and a K-80 for Doubles.

Kristi started shooting a bit later in life at the age of 15. Her parents, Don and Harriet Swangler were shooters and since Kristi was always with them at shoots, she thought she would give it a try. In 1973, her parents built Suntarget Sports in Moxee, WA and in 1974, held one of the biggest State Shoots in Washington. Kristi ran the gun club and the motocross track, and this is where her love for trapshooting really began. Kristi's first ATA registered targets were in 1980. Her first gun was a Browning, but she wanted a K-80 like Nora Martin! She got that K-80 and shot it for many years. She has shot different guns over the years and currently shoots an F3 Blaser combo. Kristi has been named to 16 All American teams, her first in 1989. She has always liked competitive sports and was the first girl in Ellensburg on a boys little league team. When she was 12 she became a member of the Ellensburg Rodeo Wranglerettes Drill Team and was involved until age 18. The Wranglerettes were an all-girl mounted drill team that traveled throughout the Pacific Northwest appearing in parades and drill team competitions as well as performing in the Junior Rodeo Night Show, Grand Entry and as a featured act in the Ellensburg Rodeo .

In 1980, Gerry bought the family business, Pautzke Bait Company, from his parents. The company processes salmon eggs for trout fishing with sales nationwide plus Europe, South America, Australia, Canada and Mexico. Busy with business and family, Gerry wasn't actively participating in registered tournaments for some time, however, his Dad was a big game hunter and together they shared some 24 African safaris. In addition, Gerry has hunted extensively throughout the world, including all Western states, Canada, Alaska, Europe, South America, Mexico, Australia, Mongolia and India. In 2005, he sold the company to his nephew who continues to operate it successfully today.

Kristi was opening the first of her many ventures as a businesswoman at the same time Gerry was taking over his family business. In 1980 she opened Salon Zuchi's in Ellensburg and bought another salon in Yakima. From there she opened her first tanning salon in Ellensburg with 16 tanning booths. The next adventure was Victoria's Lace Lingerie. The business ventures continued and in 1994, with the help of her Dad, built and operated a Red Robin Restaurant that had over 120 employees. After that came a Baskin Robbins – conveniently located right next door to the Red Robin location!

In 1997, Gerry got back into registered competition and in 1999 while both were at the Grand American in Vandalia, a group of mutual friends got together for dinner at the Shuckin' Shack. Since it was mostly couples, Kristi told Gerry he had to sit by her. While Gerry and Kristi didn't know each other all that well growing up, they did know of each other and had trapshooting in common.

After the Grand, Gerry showed up at her Red Robin Restaurant and asked her if she won the Grand American Handicap! He asked her to go on a hike and in October invited her to go to Maui for her birthday. The rest is history...he asked her to marry him and they were married while there!

The Williams eventually sold their businesses which allowed them to travel all over the country in their coach, with their pets, attending tournaments. Some years, each shooting up to 30,000 targets. They had a home in Fountain Hills for several years before becoming AZ residents in 2009 and now reside in Paradise Valley very close to Camelback Mountain. They are avid hikers and climb Camelback Mtn most mornings when they are home. They love golf and excel in that sport also. Kristi had her first hole-in-one in March of 2019!

Gerry currently serves on the ATA Trapshooting Hall of Fame, and is proud to give back to a sport that has given him so much!

They both say they have “married the love of their life.” Gerry commented, “it has been a dream and we hope it will continue.” Kristi said, “trapshooting gave me friends for a lifetime and great respect for this sport that I will cherish forever.” They have two daughters and five grandchildren. Both families live in WA.

In 2006 the Williams were inducted into the Washington State Trapshooting Hall of Fame and the day they found out they were going into the Arizona Hall of Fame was their 20th Wedding Anniversary! They are very honored to be the first Arizona couple chosen for this honor.

The Williams accomplishments are many and they are truly deserving of this recognition. Arizona is proud to claim them!
