SHOOTERS PLEASE NOTE:

- · All ties for in zone trophies will be shot off.
- Ties for all open trophies will be determined by reverse run except scores of 100 or 200 which will have to be shot off.
- Management will not be responsible for errors on scores after the options have been figured and posted on the scoreboard.
- · The clubs reserve the right to reject any entry.
- · Lunch may be obtained on the grounds.
- Anyone winning a trophy must pick it up, as no trophies will be shipped.
- This shoot will be held regardless of the weather.
- A shooter may win only one trophy in any event.
- 25 practice targets \$5.00

TROPHY HIERARCHY FOR ALL ZONE SHOOTS

Shooters may declare only one category: i.e. lady, sub-junior, junior, veteran, senior veteran. A shooter may no longer declare, for example, lady veteran. (Note: this new rule does not apply to chair shooters.)

Any shooter who is tied for event champion may shoot off/carry over for the champion trophy. If the shooter fails in the championship trophy shoot off/carry over and has declared a special category, the shooter will fall back to their declared category.

Any shooter who has declared a special category at classification and whose score qualified him/her for any trophy in his/her declared category will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group.

A category shooter whose score does not qualify him/her for his/her category may compete for place, class or yardage group.

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATION

This certifies that the New Jersey State Trapshooting Association has been authorized to hold registered shoots. Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern these shoots and the scores will be included in the Official Records.

ZONE CLASSIFICATION – 16 Yard Classification

AA 97 percent and over C 88 percent and under 91

A 94 percent and under 97 D Under 88 percent

B 91 percent and under 94

TARGET REQUIREMENTS

16 YARD: A shooter not having at least 500 16-yard targets on their 2020 card AND a total of 1000 targets on their 2019-2020 card combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class AA.

NOTE: Due to the date of the Northern Zone, the current target year will be waived.

HANDICAP: A shooter not having at least 500 handicap targets on their 2020 card AND a total of 1000 targets on their 2019-2020 card combined will be penalized 2 yards, not to exceed 26 yards.

DOUBLES: A shooter not having at least 500 double targets on their 2020 card AND a total of 1000 targets on their 2019-2020 card combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class A.

SENIOR VETERAN: Prior to 80 years of age: must have 500 singles, 300 doubles, and 300 handicap targets on their 2019 card.

ZONE TEAM SELECTIONS: When selecting tie breakers a reverse long run on tie scores will be used.



2020 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

EARL PAGLIUGHI ATA#3509718

Earl is being inducted into the New Jersey Hall of Fame as a Contributor. Earl voluntarily served as Caretaker, Vice President and a Member of the Board of Directors of Pine Valley Gun Club from 1973-2001.

Earl began his registered trapshooting career in 1971 by shooting an 86 on his first 100 targets. Needless to say, he caught the bug and the following year shot 800 singles for a 92 average. His love of breaking clays continued to grow, and



by his third year of competing he logged 1600 singles, 1500 handicap and 75 doubles.

1974 saw Earl increasing his target total by 2200 singles and 1700 caps. These were fair numbers to some but they reflected the setback he and a lot of fellow shooters encountered that year; the loss of Pine Valley's clubhouse which was destroyed by fire. That might have slowed his shooting, but it did not cause him to turn his back on his club. Instead, Earl volunteered as Pine Valley's caretaker shortly after the fire. He and others helped Julius "Bam" DeRosa rebuild the clubhouse. His target totals may have dropped over the next year during construction, but his enthusiasm for the sport never waned.

Earl continued to shoot between 3000 and 4000 singles targets for the next 7 years breaking his first 100 straight in July of '81. The following year he had a 199. He had a handful of straights, many 99's and 98's. He even shot a 98 in caps one year moving him to the 24.5 yard line. By 1989 Earl was registering over 14,000 targets a year. In 1996 he attended the Grand American at Vandalia shooting singles and handicap in 6 events. Earl concluded his shooting career in 1997 registering 232,250 singles, 55.500 handicap and 6,100 doubles targets.

Earl loved his Winchester Super X shotguns, he owned a few (for backup he said), making his own repairs and customizing when necessary.

Earl did anything and everything to help Pine Valley survive. Many of us recall seeing him stop shooting, walk off the line, and go make repairs to a bad trap so the shoot wouldn't be delayed. He took part in the installation of the modern Pat Traps, when Pine Valley upgraded their Western traps. Few people can ever remember him being in anything but a cheerful mood. He was the first to instruct a new shooter or congratulate one of us on a milestone in our careers.

Earl even involved his wife Connie, who ran the Pine Valley kitchen for many years, always providing great breakfasts and lunches for the shooters, and providing stellar meals for the holiday affairs.

Earl is survived by his daughter Diane Murray and five grandchildren.

2020 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

GEORGE WRIGHT ATA # 9103829

George was born in Salem NJ in 1949 and lived his whole life within a twenty-mile radius of his birthplace. Growing up he had the company of a brother and a sister. He learned hunting and making every shot count from his Dad. Hunting for the Wright's wasn't sport, it was to put meat on the table. George hunted rabbit, squirrel, deer and some duck hunting growing up. He worked for DuPont at their Deepwater facility at the base of



the Delaware Memorial Bridge. While at DuPont, at that site, Teflon was produced, along with tetra ethyl lead, which was used to generate octane levels in gasoline years ago. George worked there 41-years, retiring in 2010. In 1985 George moved to Carneys Point where he still resides. He started shooting trap in 1990 at the Salem County Sportsman's Club, which was, and still is, a 1-trap club. George joined the ATA in 1991 along with his then girlfriend Nvda. Nvda had ventured out first. on her own (George was racing that weekend) to Pine Valley, where she had her first encounter with New Jersey's Trapshooting Matriarch, Toots Tindall, a lasting friendship evolved from that meeting. Nyda talked George into going to Pine Valley, since she was welcomed by Toots and the other shooters there, George also shot his first registered targets at Pine Valley. They both enjoyed the sport so much they became Life Members. In April of 1992 George and Nvda were married. In 1994 George and Nyda bought their first motorhome. This allowed them the chance to get out and see what trapshooting was all about. They would venture out of Salem County to shoot registered targets at the clubs of New Jersey and Delaware at first. George also was involved in micro-midget racing on dirt tracks. He enjoyed fabricating parts on the racecar, assembling and disassembling the engines. He raced at Airport Speedway in nearby Delaware. George stopped racing in 1997. George's shooting steadily increased starting with the number of targets registered each year and the steady increase of his shooting average. By 1998 he finished the year with a 96.21 average in singles and never looked back. He has been an A or AA singles shooter and a B or A doubles shooter ever since. His most memorable victory was winning New Jersey State Singles Championship in 2009, with a 200x200. His first State Team appearance was in 2002 and has been on fourteen more, capping off with being on the 2019 New Jersey Veterans Team. George also was the New Jersey State Doubles Champion in 2013 and 2018. On the National Level, George has made the All-American Team in 2016, 2018 and 2019. So far, George has registered 98,300 singles: 78,450 handicap and 65,550 doubles target in his shooting career.

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

A competent classification committee will be on duty and all shooters will be classified and/or handicapped according to A.T.A. regulations, averages, past year's performance and known ability, which includes non-registered shooting.

Shooters who do not have their scores posted and averaged up-to-date on their A.T.A. cards will be assigned Class and Yardage at the discretion of the committee.

CLASS - YARDAGE ADVANCEMENT

Beginning day one, any shooter who wins and/or ties for a singles or doubles championship trophy or class trophy or has the high score in that event or class, shall be increased a minimum of one class. Shooters earning yardage must have their card punched before participating in their next handicap event.

TARGET REQUIREMENTS

16 YARD: A shooter not having at least 500 16-yard targets on their 2020 card AND a total of 1000 16-yard targets on their 2019-2020 card combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class AA.

HANDICAP: A shooter not having at least 500 handicap targets on their 2020 card AND a total of 1000 handicap targets on their 2019-2020 card combined will be penalized 2 yards, not to exceed 26 yards.

DOUBLES: A shooter not having at least 500 double targets on their 2020 card AND a total of 1000 doubles targets on their 2019-2020 card combined will be penalized 2 classes, not to exceed Class A.

SENIOR VETERAN: Prior to 80 years of age: must have 500 singles, 300 doubles, and 300 handicap targets on their 2020 card.
