This event will be shot in three 100 target rounds. Any yardage earned will be awarded before each round and, if needed, shooter will be resquaded with new yardage.

ATA Daily Fee \$3.00 CSTA Daily Fee \$4.50

All shooters must have current ATA Cards and CSTA Stickers

All options must be paid in cash and will be paid out at end of day.

Target Certificates may be used and will be redeemed at \$24 per hundred, shooter must pay the difference.

Trophies awarded to Event Champion and Winners of each yardage group and category for all 300 targets. If participation exceeds 50 shooters, a runner up trophy will be added for event, yardage and category.

No refunds for event, purse or option allowed after a squad has started event.

No purse or option money may be entered after a squad has started event.

Classification will be determined by the higher of last year's average or the last 500 registered targets shot. Shooters without established handicaps or class will be classified as "B" shooters with a handicap of 20 yards or as determined by ATA procedure.

97% and over: AA 94% and under 97% A 91% and under 94% B 88% and under 91% C Under 88% D

Doubles:

93% and over: AA 89% and under 93% A 85% and under 89% B 78% and under 85% C Under 78% D

First event begins at 9:00 am
Practice opens at 8:00 am – cost is \$6.00/rd
Practice fields will be available all day.
