ATA rules will govern this shoot and will be strictly enforced. All targets are registered.

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the shooter's classification at any time.

Any shooter leaving the grounds will forfeit a shoot-off. Any shooter, who does not appear for a shoot-off when called, forfeits all rights. Contestants will be called 1st call, 2nd call and final call. No response after final call – shooter forfeits. The OCSC Directors reserve the right to decide ties by other means for, but not limited to, inclement weather.

PENALTY FOR EVENT 5: Shooters who do not have a total of 500 Handicap targets will be advanced to the 25 yard line. Due to COVID-19, the look back period will be extended to September 1, 2018.

The club is not responsible for theft, fire or accidents.

No prizes may be taken by winners until signed for with the Awards Committee. All shells for this shoot must be picked up the day of the shoot.

All prize and option money will be mailed.

Once an event has started, only target monies will be refunded upon request in the case of withdrawal.

Event 4 –100 Preliminary Handicap

Targets \$8.53 (tax \$0.60), Service Fee \$12.57 (tax \$0.88), Prize \$6 (tax \$0.42) = \$29
\$6 from each entry paid 60-40%, High Gun in each group

Entry: \$29 Targets, Service, Prize & Tax

Lewis: \$10 3 Classes – 60-40% High Gun

50's: \$15 Front, Middle, Back, Divided 60-40% Ties Divide

NOTE: If you shoot a 96 or higher and/or believe you got a yardage punch in Event 4; please come to the clubhouse and see a Director immediately after your done shooting!

Event 5 – 100 Championship Handicap

Targets \$8.53 (tax \$0.60), Service Fee \$12.57 (tax \$0.88), Prize \$49 (tax \$3.42) = \$75

Entry: \$75 Targets, Service, Prize & Tax

Lewis: \$10 3 Classes – 60-40% High Gun

50's: \$15 Front, Middle, Back, Divided 60-40% Ties Divide

200 Lewis: \$20 3 Classes – One Money (combined scores from Events 4 & 5)

Prizes: **Champion** \$1,000

Runner Up \$600

3rd Place \$400

Shoot-offs: Will be for Champion, Runner-up & 3rd Place only
Loser(s) of 3rd place shoot-off will fall back to yardage group

Yardage Group: **1st in each yardage group** 6 flats of shells (ties divide)

2nd in each yardage group 4 flats of shells (ties divide)

3rd in each yardage group 2 flats of shells (ties divide)

4th in each yardage group 1 flat of shells (ties divide)

Special Category (Jr, Vet, Lady): 2 flats of shells (ties divide) *must have min. 3 entries in each category

PLEASE NOTE: Champion, Runner Up and 3rd Place **will not be eligible** for prizes in yardage groups and special categories.

High Overall on Events 1-5 (500 Targets): Belt Buckle
