ENTRY TICKETS

Entry tickets for Events 1 - 4 will be available on Thursday morning.

Entry tickets for Friday, Saturday and Sunday's Events 5 - 10 will be available on Thursday from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM. Entries taken on Saturday morning will be limited to the Singles Event 8.

Entries for Doubles Event 9 and Handicap Event 10 will be taken after the 2nd 100 targets have started on Saturday.

BANK SYSTEM - 6 BANKS ON (2) ADJACENT TRAPS

Thursday - 5 BANKS

Friday thru Sunday - 6 BANKS

Doubles - 8 Fields

The shoot will be conducted using the bank system of two adjacent trap fields for the Singles and Handicap Events. The number of Doubles traps will be determined by the number of entries in each Event.

Banks will not be randomized. Squad 1 will start on Bank 1.

Each Bank will have a limited number of squads assigned to it.

When a bank is full, it is FULL. Shooters who prefer a specific bank, squad, or shooting time are urged to presquad using Presquad.com.

BRING TWO BOXES OF SHELLS TO THE LINE

Please bring **two full boxes of shells to the line** on each trap so no time is wasted going back to the gun rack. This is a requirement for Championship Singles and will help avoid shooting ten targets per station.

Using 2 box system in other events will be at managements' discretion.

MATA GENERAL INFO (CON'T)

RESIDENT JUNIOR & SUB-JUNIOR TARGET FEES

Any resident Junior or Sub-Junior, who has at least 300 singles targets for the current year, will pay \$44.00 for targets plus fees in Saturday's 200 Singles Event, if no purses or options are played.

STATE SHOOT REFEREES

MATA Officers in conjunction with shoot management will act as official line referees and act as the committee to rule on any disputes and reserve the right to refuse any entry, to change or cancel all or any part of the program or adjust traps at any time, as circumstances require.

MATA MEMBERSHIP

Per ATA rules, all Massachusetts resident shooters are required to be members of the MATA. Annual members receive a decal to be placed on their ATA card to prove membership.

TROPHIES

Only *Resident* MATA members are eligible for resident trophies & resident added money.

Nonresident shooters are eligible for nonresident trophies.

All shooters are eligible for open trophies & open money.

All Around class trophies are based on the shooter's Saturday singles class. Shooters are eligible for only one trophy per event.

HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARD

The Trapshooting Hall of Fame maintains a museum, provides a research library for the history of the sport and awards college scholarships.

Half of the HOF Lewis entry is donated to the Hall of Fame. We encourage you to participate and support its various activities.

ATA REFUND

The 2019 ATA refund for dues and daily fees for Massachusetts amounted to \$2,644.00.

2020 MA STATE SHOOT HONOREES

“THE KAZENS”

Carl started shooting competitively on his high school rifle team and went on to compete on his college Army ROTC Rifle Team.

Evelyn was born and raised on a farm in Vermont and was deer hunting with her dad at an early age. It was natural that two shooters who grew up in different environments would get together when they discovered their mutual love for the shooting sports.

Carl started shooting trap on leagues in the 80's and joined the ATA in 1987. His first Grand American trophy was a Doubles Class win in 1992. Evelyn joined the ATA in 1987 also but didn't shoot regularly as the demands of raising children took precedence. She finally joined Carl's Grand American squad in Vandalia, Ohio in 1999 where she shot a 199 and won an evening shoot-off for the Class Championship.

In 2007 Evelyn had the distinct honor of winning the coveted Lady Clay Target Championship of America at the Grand American in Sparta, Illinois. A night time shoot-off against a determined 22 year old All American from California began and by 11:00 pm that evening it was over with Evelyn winning the national title. She is the only woman in New England to have ever won the Clay Target Championship.

In 2009, at the Northeast Grand, Evelyn won the High All Around with a 198 in the singles, a 96 in the doubles and a 93 in the handicap from 25 yards in difficult weather conditions coupled with a severe ACL tear in her right knee, defeating Debbie Ohye and Stephanie Sandler, both accomplished All Americans.

In 2013 she won the Lady Doubles award at the Grand American as well as Lady High-All-Around and High-Over-All trophies. She made the Ladies All American Team for five consecutive years.

Both Carl and Evelyn also had the pleasure of competing together at the Grand American in the Champion of Champions event after winning two Massachusetts state titles, Evelyn the Ladies title and Carl the Sub Vet award.

Carl contributed to the family trophy case with awards in the Parliament Handicap at the Grand American in 2008, a Grand American Doubles trophy in 2013 plus singles and doubles events at Eastern Zone shoots, the Pennsylvania State Shoot, the Florida State Shoot and the Pennsylvania Grand.

In the last 20 years of their cumulative shooting careers Carl and Evelyn won many Massachusetts State Shoot, New England area State Shoots and Satellite Grand trophies. With the exception of a very few Husband and Wife couples they have probably won more trophies collectively than most other married couples in the New England area.

It is with great fondness that they look back on all the wonderful friends and great memories they've made in the last 20 years in the trapshooting world. Both Evelyn and Carl express their gratitude at being honored as the 2020 MA State shoot honorees

CLASSIFICATION

(Plus Known Ability)

Classification will be based on the last 700 targets, or total average, whichever is greater. Our ATA State Delegate is chairman of the Classification Committee. It is the shooter's responsibility to keep their average card up to date. *If **NOT**, shooters may be classified in Class AA.*

It is the shooter's responsibility to make **category declaration** when classified. Errors in classification could result in disqualification.

All Massachusetts residents must show their current MATA decal on their ATA card when being classified. Please have your ATA card and average card with you when classifying.

PENALTY

Shooters must have at least 700 singles, 700 handicap and 300 doubles for the current and previous year combined to avoid penalty.

Targets shot on Thursday and Friday may be counted toward minimum requirements for classification on Saturday's and Sunday's Events.

Adult male shooters will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yardage, subject to a 23-yard minimum and a 25-yard maximum. Ladies, Juniors, and Sub Juniors will follow the same rules except the minimum penalty yardage will be 21 yards. Adult males may shoot their yardage, but are not eligible for trophies or money. There will be no penalty yardage assigned to Senior Veterans.

Mission Statement

The mission of the Massachusetts Trapshooting Hall of Fame is to honor and reward those persons who have contributed to the sport of trapshooting for 15 consecutive or cumulative years by a record of outstanding shooting accomplishments, a history of service to the MATA as an officer or Committee member, a history of contributions to the sport that might include introduction of new shooters to trapshooting and the MATA with an emphasis on sportsmanship or a combination of any of the above.

The committee will consist of seven members who will meet 2 - 5 times a year to review the submitted records of the nominees.

Voting will be by telephonic or paper ballot and a simple majority will be required for induction. The nominee's names and the committees' voting results will remain undisclosed until the Hall of Fame Committee Chairperson notifies the nominator and nominee. One member will be responsible for minutes, which will be archived.

- The candidate must have been an active member of the ATA and MATA. He or she must have been an outstanding participant in either the shooting venue or service to the MATA as an officer or Committee member, a history of contributions to the sport that might include the introduction of new shooters to trapshooting and the MATA, or a combination of any of the above for a period of no less than 15 cumulative years. The individual must also have demonstrated true sportsmanship during that period.
- For shooting accomplishments, a concise written shooting record must be submitted; this can be obtained from the ATA if unavailable through local research (there is a nominal fee to acquire a written shooters history report from the ATA). The nominator may call or send email to the ATA office for this information.
- For service accomplishments there must be a written statement that shows either dedicated service as an officer or Committee Member in the MATA or contributor to the sport of trapshooting for a period of no less than 15 consecutive years. It should contain information about the types of service, dates,

and contributions to the sport and/or how the individual enhanced the sport.

- Any nominee may have a combination of any of the above and needs to have written documentation of all categories that apply.
- All nomination requests must be clearly written and may be submitted to any committee member. The nominator must provide the Hall of Fame Committee with the individuals name; address and ATA number along with the nominators contact phone number or email address.
- The committee will meet to discuss and vote on the nomination. A majority vote of acceptance will be required and the committee chair will notify the nominator and nominee in writing of the Hall of Fame Committees decision.

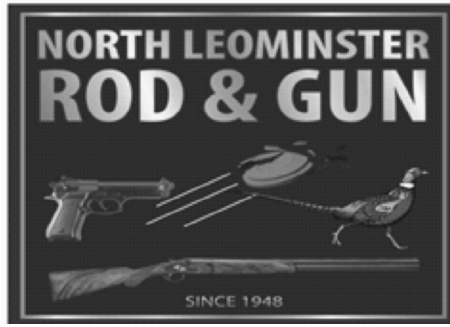
