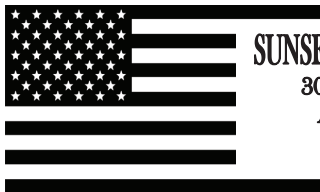

GENERAL INFORMATION

A.T.A. rules will govern this shoot and will be strictly enforced. All targets are registered.

16 yard winners and ties on Saturday will be advanced a class on the following day.

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the shooter's classification at any time.

Penalty for Event 5: Shooters who do not have a total of 500 Handicap targets will be advanced to the 25 yard line. Due to COVID-19 the look back period will be extended to September 1, 2018.

Any shooter leaving the grounds will forfeit a shoot-off. Any shooter who does not appear for a shoot-off when called forfeits all rights. The OCSC Directors reserve the right to decide ties by other means for, but not limited, inclement weather. Contestants will be called, 1st call, 2nd call, final call. No response after final call – shooter forfeits. PENALTIES: Shooters who do not have a total of 500 Singles/500 Handicap/250 Doubles targets registered in the current target year will be advanced 1 class/yardage group at the discretion of the Directors.

The club is not responsible for theft, fire or accidents.

No prizes may be taken by winners until signed for with the Awards Committee. All shells for this shoot must be picked up the day of the shoot.

All prizes and option money will be mailed.

Once an event has started, only target monies will be refunded upon request in case of withdrawal.

Food will be available at the clubhouse.

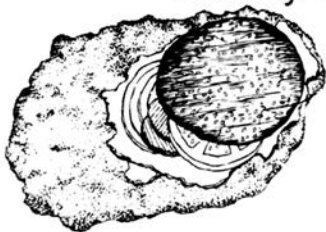

Nora Martin Ross is a 34-time Amateur Trapshooting Association All-American. One of her most amazing accomplishments came in 1990 when she became the first woman to break 100 straight doubles at the Grand American Trap Shoot, where she scored a 120 x 120 in a shoot off to capture the ATA Championship. Nora became the youngest person ever inducted into the ATA Hall of Fame in 1999.

Nora has shared her expertise traveling all over the United States conducting clinics to sharpen the skills of trapshooters. Nora's students have said time and time again that they walked away from her clinic equipped with knowledge that would help them continue to improve their shooting. 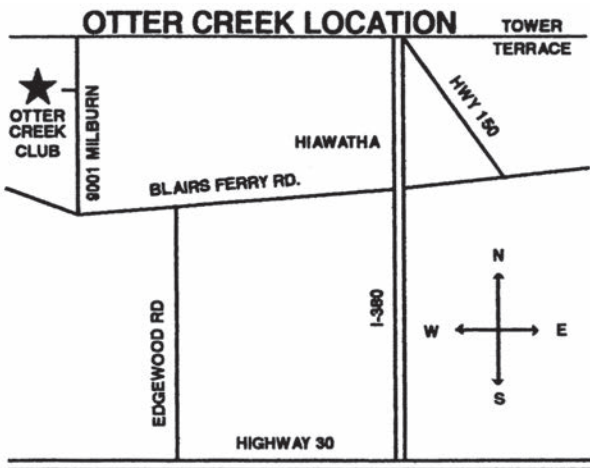
