GENERAL INFORMATION

It is the responsibility of the shooter to be informed of the contents of this program and rules governing ATA sanctioned shoots. All shooters must be classified before making their entries. On Championship Singles, target fees for all resident sub juniors, juniors & junior gold will be reduced by 50% provided no monies are played. They will be eligible for added monies.

1. Management reserves the right to reject any entry and make changes to the program.

2. Anyone violating any of the rules may be disqualified and will not share in any prize money or trophies.

3. Shooters and spectators assume all responsibilities of any and all accidents.

4. The MTA President and State ATA Delegate , and designees, will act as a Committee to rule on all disputes.

5. White Flyer Orange Top Pitch Targets will be thrown.

6. All Banks will be drawn at random. Event targets will be shot on 8 fields shooting **50 per field**, using the **"Quick 50"** format. Please take 2 boxes of shells to the line.

7.The practice field will be open at 4pm Wednesday, July 14th and during the tournament. Practice rounds are \$6.00 per 25.

8. Trophies will be available for pick up each day and will not be mailed.

9. Cell phones and pagers not allowed on the line.

10. Campsites and RV parking are available. Fee is \$20.00 per night on a first come first served basis. Sites include water but no power. Camper access is available on or after Saturday, July 10th.

11.It is the shooter's responsibility to verify his/her scores on both the scoresheets and score board. Once purses and options are figured they will not be changed. However; scores will be corrected for record purposes.

12. Strict adherence to ATA and SF&G club rules regarding alcohol , drugs and eye and ear protection will be observed.

13. Ties in singles and doubles on Thursday and Friday will be carried over by sub event to the next like event Ties in Handicap will be shot off.

14. To pre-squad please log on to <u>www.PreSquad.com</u>. Pre-Squad started May 17th and ends on June 26th.

16. Classification will be available Wednesday evening from 5pm to 7 pm. Classification will begin at 7:30 am on shoot days.

15. Special category shooters must declare their category at time of classification and verify it is indicated on their receipt. Saturday's single classification will determine the High All Around Class.

17. There will be a meeting of the MTA membership Sunday between events for the purpose of electing the MTA Delegate and Alternate. All resident Maine shooters are encouraged to attend.

18. The Shriner's Cycle Corps will serve food from 7:30am to 4:00pm. For your Saturday night lobster dinner sign up and pay at the Cycle Corps food concession.

It is the shooters responsibility to make category declaration when classified.

Adult male, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran and Veteran shooters not meeting target requirements will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yard age, subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum. Ladies (1&2), Sub Juniors and Juniors will follow the same rules except the minimum penalty will be 21 yards. There will be no penalty yardage to shooters who are 70 years or older. Any shooter may elect to shoot for targets only and be exempted from penalty yardage. However; said person will not be allowed to play purses or options and for feits all rights to added monies and trophies.
