

MATA GENERAL INFORMATION

ENTRY TICKETS

Entry tickets for Events 1 - 4 will be available on Thursday morning. Entry tickets for Friday, Saturday and Sunday's Events 5 - 10 will be available on Thursday from 1:30 PM to 4:00 PM. Entries taken on Saturday morning will be limited to the Singles Event 8. Entries for Doubles Event 9 and Handicap Event 10 will be taken after the 2nd 100 targets have started on Saturday. Pre-squadding is available at Presquad.com. See page 3.

BANK SYSTEM - 6 BANKS ON (2) ADJACENT TRAPS

Thursday - 5 BANKS
Friday thru Sunday - 6 BANKS
Doubles - 8 Fields

The shoot will be conducted using the bank system of two adjacent trap fields for the Singles and Handicap Events. The number of Doubles traps will be determined by the number of entries in each Event.

Banks will not be randomized. Squad 1 will start on Bank 1. Each Bank will have a limited number of squads assigned to it. When a bank is full, it is FULL. Shooters who prefer a specific bank, squad, or shooting time are urged to presquad using Presquad.com.

BRING TWO BOXES OF SHELLS TO THE LINE

Please bring **two full boxes of shells to the line** on each trap so no time is wasted going back to the gun rack. This is a requirement for Championship Singles and will help avoid shooting ten targets per station. Using 2 box system in other events will be at managements' discretion.

MATA GENERAL INFO (CON'T)

RESIDENT JUNIOR & SUB-JUNIOR TARGET FEES

Any resident Junior or Sub-Junior, who has at least 300 singles targets for the current year, will pay \$44.00 for targets plus fees in Saturday's 200 Singles Event, if no purses or options are played.

STATE SHOOT REFEREES

MATA Officers in conjunction with shoot management will act as official line referees and act as the committee to rule on any disputes and reserve the right to refuse any entry, to change or cancel all or any part of the program or adjust traps at any time, as circumstances require.

MATA MEMBERSHIP

Per ATA rules, *ALL* Massachusetts resident shooters are required to be members of the MATA. Annual members receive a decal to be placed on their ATA card to prove membership.

TROPHIES

Only Resident MATA members are eligible for resident trophies & resident added money.

Nonresident shooters are eligible for nonresident trophies.

All shooters are eligible for open trophies & open money.

All Around class trophies are based on the shooter's Saturday singles class. Shooters are eligible for only one trophy per event.

HALL OF FAME CONTRIBUTOR AWARD

The Trapshooting Hall of Fame maintains a museum, provides a research library for the history of the sport and awards college scholarships.

Half of the HOF Lewis entry is donated to the Hall of Fame. We encourage you to participate and support its various activities.

ATA REFUND

The 2020 ATA refund for dues and daily fees for Massachusetts amounted to \$1,766.00.

2021 MA STATE SHOOT HONOREE BOB SCOTT

Bob Scott is usually found surrounded by family and friends, a busy guy juggling family, his contracting business of 36 years and shooting, always with a phone stuck to his head. He can be spotted in the ATA website when you print your average card, probably telling someone how much fun the Grand American is. If you know Bob, his family is especially important to him, often visiting at many of the shoots. His 4 daughters have been involved, helping at local shoots and benefits.

Bob started his trap career by shooting at targets off the side of a cruise ship. He won his first trophy there, a bottle of champagne. THAT WAS IT!!! "HE WAS HOOKED". Bob started shooting registered targets in 2005, and currently has 52,200 Singles, 41,000 Handicap, and 44,100 Doubles registered targets

Shooting accomplishments of note are MA State Handicap Runner-Up 2014 and 2020, Handicap Champion 2016 and the High Handicap average for 2011. He was Runner up at the Southern Grand in a Handicap event with a score of 98/100. Bob Is always willing to go compete at the local shoots, as well as the state and national events. For many years Bob had the top target attainment for a Massachusetts resident, and has been named to the state team numerous times.

Bob is the Trap chairman at Woburn Sportsmen's Association. He has brought registered league shooting to WSA and the Club has ranked 5th in the country for league targets thrown since. He spearheaded a lead reclamation program at WSA, yielding Gipson Ricketts, LLC the highest amount of lead reclaimed in a single day. He was also able to bring the country's leading trap shooter, Harlan Campbell, to WSA for clinics to help shooters improve their game.

Bob, with the support of others, was instrumental in starting the "Take Aim at Cancer" benefit shoot. This shoot quickly became a favorite for many shooters. It grew so big; it was moved to Minuteman Sportsman's Club to handle the number of competitors. To date, this shoot has raised over \$240,000 for breast cancer research, and it continues to grow today with the help of Vista Outdoors

Bob has been VP of the MATA for 5 years and in this time; he has positively influenced the sport. He pushed for the addition of a 4th day at the MA State Shoot, increasing the targets 1,100 - making it the largest state shoot in the Northeast! Also, constantly working to improve the shooter experience, he changed the MATA trophies, and took the "Bull by the Horns" to raise funding for an all Pat Trap presentation.

One of the things that Bob is most noted for is his ability to make the game fun for as many shooters as possible. He hosts the *RA Soiree's* and can be found at the campsites or trap line making people welcome and having fun. Bob has acquired a large shooting family that he shares his love of the sport, a squad mate who is always there, with integrity and a smile.

Bob is a true Ambassador of Trap, striving for what is right, and making the sport fun for all.

CLASSIFICATION

Classification will be based on the last 700 targets, total average or known ability whichever is higher. The MA ATA Delegate is chairman of the Classification Committee. It is the shooter's responsibility to see that his/her ATA average card is correct and up-to-date. Falsified cards submitted will result in disqualification. It is the shooters responsibility to make category **declaration** when classified.

All Massachusetts residents must show their ATA card with with the current MATA decal at time of classification.

PENALTY

Shooters must have at least 700 singles, 700 handicap and 300 doubles in the current and previous target year combined to avoid penalty classification. Targets shot on Thursday and Friday may be applied toward meeting target requirements. It is the shooter's responsibility to notify the classification committee of meeting target requirements.

Singles Class B or higher
Doubles Class B or higher
Handicap (see below)

Adult male, Junior Gold and Sub-Veteran shooters not meeting target requirements will be assigned 2 yards over their normal yardage, subject to a 23-yard minimum and a 25-yard maximum. Ladies (I & II), Juniors and Sub-Juniors will follow the same rules, except the minimum penalty yardage will be 21 yards. There will be no penalty yardage assigned to shooters who are 70 years or older. Any shooter may elect to shoot for targets only and be exempted from penalty yardage. However, said shooter will not be allowed to play purses or options and forfeits all rights to added money and trophies by doing so.

Mission Statement

The mission of the Massachusetts Trapshooting Hall of Fame is to honor and reward those persons who have contributed to the sport of trapshooting for 15 consecutive or cumulative years by a record of outstanding shooting accomplishments, a history of service to the MATA as an officer or Committee member, a history of contributions to the sport that might include introduction of new shooters to trapshooting and the MATA with an emphasis on sportsmanship or a combination of any of the above.

The committee will consist of seven members who will meet 2 - 5 times a year to review the submitted records of the nominees. Voting will be by telephonic or paper ballot and a simple majority will be required for induction. The nominee's names and the committees' voting results will remain undisclosed until the Hall of Fame Committee Chairperson notifies the nominator and nominee. One member will be responsible for minutes, which will be archived.

- The candidate must have been an active member of the ATA and MATA. He or she must have been an outstanding participant in either the shooting venue or service to the MATA as an officer or Committee member, a history of contributions to the sport that might include the introduction of new shooters to trapshooting and the MATA, or a combination of any of the above for a period of no less than 15 cumulative years. The individual must also have demonstrated true sportsmanship during that period.
- For shooting accomplishments, a concise written shooting record must be submitted; this can be obtained from the ATA if unavailable through local research (there is a nominal fee to acquire a written shooters history report from the ATA). The nominator may call or send email to the ATA office for this information.
- For service accomplishments there must be a written statement that shows either dedicated service as an officer or Committee Member in the MATA or contributor to the sport of trapshooting for a period of no less than 15 consecutive years. It should contain information about the types of service, dates, and contributions to the sport and/or how the individual enhanced the sport.

- Any nominee may have a combination of any of the above and needs to have written documentation of all categories that apply.
- All nomination requests must be clearly written and may be submitted to any committee member. The nominator must provide the Hall of Fame Committee with the individuals name; address and ATA number along with the nominators contact phone number or email address.
- The committee will meet to discuss and vote on the nomination. A
 majority vote of acceptance will be required and the committee
 chair will notify the nominator and nominee in writing of the Hall of
 Fame Committees decision.
