- **1.** Classification/squadding and practice opens at 8:00 AM each day. Events start at 9:30 AM each day.
- 2. Entries for the first event each day must be cashiered no later than 30 minutes after the event starts.
- 3. Targets may be cross-registered with PITA. PITA Daily Fees \$4, AZ \$2
- **4.** Juniors and Sub Juniors will be offered \$20/100 entry fees courtesy of 2 Lazy 2 and the ASTA.
- 5. HOF Attendance Pins for Participants
- 6. HOF 100/200 Straight Pins on Championship Events

Edens, the first AZ State Singles Champion over 100 years ago and fellow nationally know competitor George T. Peter, recognizing and celebrating our past ASTA HOF Members - and celebrating YOU, the shooters of today that keep our great sport alive! We hope you can join us.

The HOF festivities and tribute to past HOF members will take place on Saturday following the Hall of Fame Singles Championship. Details are still being finalized for our customary buffet dinner and will be announced during the shoot. Door prizes will be given out and AZ HoF 100/200 straight pins will be awarded.

The 10th Annual Resident Zone Team Challenge will be contested concurrently with the Hall of Fame Championship Events on Saturday and Sunday (400 targets). Start recruiting your teams now! The winning team receives \$500 and each member, a beautiful custom buckle from Montana Silversmiths. Please see complete details on Page 9.

The Resident Zone HAA winner from each Zone receives a custom belt buckle from Montana Silversmiths plus \$100. (You do not need to be on a Zone Team to be eligible)

The Open HAA Champ will be awarded a custom buckle and \$100.

Due to the pandemic, this year's tournament was moved to October. Please mark your calendars for the 2022 Hall of Fame Classic which will return to the normal scheduled dates of January 12-16, 2022!

ASTA Board of Directors

Tournament Rules

- 1. Arizona Residents must be current ASTA members at the time of classification/entry.
- Daily Fees will be charged once per day per participant. ATA \$3 ASTA \$2
- 3. ATA Rules govern all events. By entering an event, shooters agree to abide by all ATA Rules and Regulations and to accept all official decisions.
- 4. Classification will be in accordance with current ATA Rules and based on the shooter's official ATA registered averages and known ability. Please have your average card up to date to ensure proper classification. There will be five classes, five categories and four yardage groups. There will be no class or yardage penalties.
- 5. If you wish to declare a special category, Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior or Sub-junior, it must be done at the time of classification/entry. Dual category shooters may only declare one category. A special category shooter whose event score qualifies for a special category trophy is not eligible for class or yardage trophies. A special category shooter whose event score does not qualify for a special category trophy is eligible for class or yardage group trophies. Changes will not be made after the shooter's first shot has been fired unless it is due to a classification error. Please check your cashier's sheet to make sure you have been classified correctly.
- 6. Ties will be carried over to the next like event. Handicap ties will be shot off if any of the involved shooters has a yardage change. There will be no class advancements for this shoot, however, any shooter's class/score is subject to review. Any remaining ties will be shot off Sunday following the handicap.
- 7. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on the practice trap due to missed squads or gun repairs. Make-ups must be completed immediately following the event.
- 8. Any shooter who has not received monies won during this tournament, agrees that payment in the form of a check will be mailed to the address indicated by ATA records. When mailed, neither 2 Lazy 2, the BACTC or the ASTA will be liable for any checks lost, stolen, unclaimed, undelivered or otherwise not received by the shooter. Checks not cashed within 90 days will become void.
- The consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs prior to shooting in any event, including shoot-offs and practice, is not allowed and will result in disqualification of any scores shot.
- 10. Management reserves the right to change/modify the shoot program at their discretion if deemed necessary.

The Arizona State Trapshooting Hall of Fame 2021 Inductees

Records reflect the first AZ State Championship Tournament occurred in 1914 and continued yearly until 1921. Between 1933 and 1947, there are no existing State Shoot Tournament Records.

Going back over 100 years, we are pleased to induct two Arizona trapshooting pioneers into the Arizona Trapshooting Hall of Fame. We do not have much personal information on these fine shooters and competitors, but their shooting expertise is a part of Arizona Trapshooting history. We start with the very first Arizona State Singles Champion - T.L. Edens.

 No substitutions are allowed. Make sure your team members will be shooting all of the Championship Events.
- ♦Zone team members do not need to be on the same squad
- ♦There is no limit on the number of teams that can enter
- ◆There is no fee to enter the Zone Team Challenge

In the event of a tie, the team with the highest combined handicap score will determine the winner. If not resolved, then the hightest combined doubles score will be used.
