10-Belt Buckles Three Lewis Classes

DETAILS

- We will throw 300 registered doubles, (150 pair) dividing them into <u>THREE</u> 100 bird *"trophy events"* and award THREE belt buckles in each *"trophy event"* on a Lewis Class system.
- To appeal to shooters at all skill levels we will award THREE belt buckles in each "100 Target Event". High gun plus two Lewis Class Scores.
- To eliminate a clean sweep, a shooter may not win more than <u>one</u> of the three high gun buckles, but is eligible to win the H.O.A. buckle and any Lewis Class buckle.
- Should a shooter repeat as high gun score (or tie) in a succeeding event, the high gun buckle will go to the tied scored or a 2nd high score.
- All ties for buckles will be decided byreverse scores by hundreds, (3rd-2nd-1st) if still tied for long run from the front, and if still tied long run from the back.
