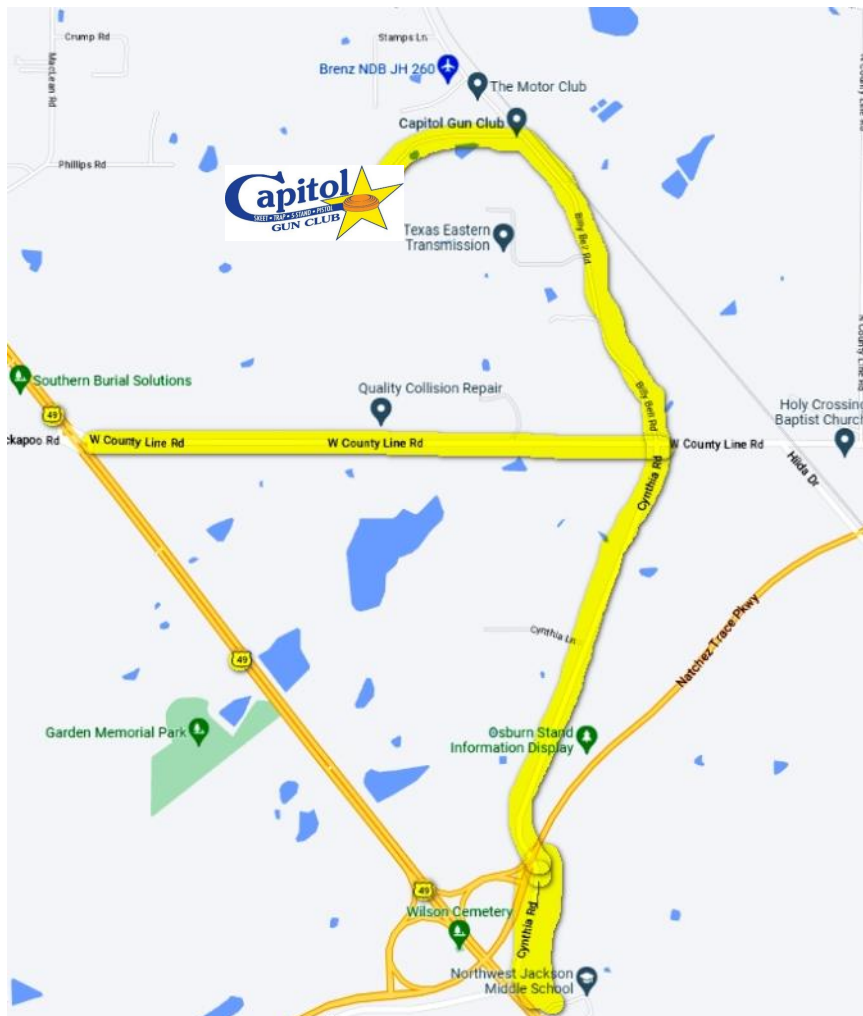

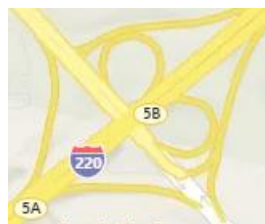

ANNUAL MISSISSIPPI STATE TRAPSHOOT

**Capitol Gun Club will be open at 7:00 a.m. each day
and program shooting will begin at 8:30 a.m.**

1. This tournament will begin Thursday, May 25, 2022.
 - a. Events 1 through 6 will be Open Events.
 - b. Events 7 through 9 will be the Mississippi Championships. (Trophies and prizes for Resident and Non-Resident winners)
2. Daily fees: ATA-\$3.00, MTA-\$3.00.
3. Program targets will be \$38.00 per 100. Practice targets will be \$7.00 per 25 for singles or handicap and \$7.00 per 12 pair of doubles.
4. You may use your own shells including reloads. All shells and reloads must meet ATA specifications and rules.
5. There are no compulsory purses.
7. Capitol Gun Club opens Wednesday, May 24th from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm for pre-registration, squadding and practice.
8. **All squadding will be performed using PreSquad.com.** After PreSquad closes, squadding will be available on a “1st come 1st served” basis only. It is highly recommended to PreSquad otherwise you may find events filled. You may not be able to register if not pre-squadded. PreSquad opens @ 6:00 pm March 15, 2023 and closes @ 6:00 pm on May 20, 2023.
9. **All SQUADDING and RESQUADING shall close 30 minutes prior to the event.**
10. Upon entry, a competitor must complete said event in order to qualify for any associated trophy or prizes.
11. For this tournament where Handicap is divided into yardages: 19-21.5 shall be Short yardage; 22-24.5 shall be Mid-Yardage and 25-27 shall be Long Yardage.

Shoot Management will make all program interpretations.

**SHOOT MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MODIFY
THIS PROGRAM AT ANY TIME AS NECESSARY**

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Before leaving the registration table, check your classifications, handicap yardage and Special Categories (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sr. Veteran, Veteran, Sub Vet, Junior, Sub-Junior, Junior Gold, Chair Shooter) to see if the Handicap Committee has correctly marked your Entry Sheet. **It is your responsibility to know the rules.** You are subject to penalties for shooting in the wrong classification or wrong yardage.
2. It is the responsibility of Special Category shooters to see that they are so designated on their entry cards and on the scoreboard bulletin sheets. Report any omission to the scoreboard attendant or a member of the Handicap Committee.
3. **Entry fees shall be paid in cash or by personal checks.** The cashier will not accept counter checks, second party checks, or credit cards. **No exceptions.**
4. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on any one event if he or she missed their squad. If you are unable to join your squad before they have started their third post, you must re-squad. All make-ups for either missed squads or gun repairs must report to the Handicap Committee prior to when the last squad takes the line for that particular event.
5. **This shoot will be governed by current ATA Rules. By entering the competition, every person agrees to accept all official decisions and to abide by the ATA rules.**
6. Please check your score after firing at each post. The squad leader (No. 1 shooter) will total the scores for each member of the squad after 25 targets and initial the score sheets. Errors made in totaling will be corrected when discovered. However, all changes in lost or dead targets will be made in the strict accordance with ATA rules.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Should you win your class in any 16 yard event, or in any 100 target doubles event, or earn yardage in any handicap event, it shall be your duty to report to the handicap table and have your yardage or classification reviewed. Any Shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason shall be considered to have been notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin board.
2. Any Shooter failing to carry out Rule 1, or who shoots in a class or a yardage marked higher or lower than that which is marked on their card, will be subject to penalty and will not be eligible to share any money division or trophy whatsoever.
3. No Shooter may win more than one trophy or prize money in the same event. Trophy priority shall be determined by shoot management and/or applicable A.T.A. rules.
4. In this program, a Sub-Junior is any shooter who has not reached his or her 15th birthday. A Junior is any shooter who is 15 but has not reached 18 years of age. A Junior Gold is any shooter who is 18 but has not reached 23 years of age. A Sub Veteran is a shooter who is 55 but has not reached 65 years of age. A Veteran is a shooter 65 through 69 years of age. A Senior Veteran is a Shooter 70 years of age or older. A Lady I is a female who has not reached 55 years of age. A Lady II is a female 55 and older. New ATA rulings apply.
5. Each Shooter who is entitled to receive money won during any event agrees that if such money is not received by him during the period of this tournament, a check in payment for the money won will be mailed to him at the address indicated by ATA records, and when so mailed, the Club will not be liable in any manner whatsoever for any check lost, stolen, unclaimed, undelivered or otherwise not received by the shooter. **Checks are considered void after 90 days.**
6. Hearing and eye protection is required at all times when forward of the yellow rope. Only shooters and officials are allowed on the field, Violations by non- participants may result in removal.
7. NO ENTRIES REFUNDED UNLESS EVENT IS CANCELLED.

Rules and Regulations Continued

8. Targets will be set each morning by the Target Setting Committee. Targets will be reset only by the Target Setting Committee.
9. Class winners and ties in Preliminary Singles and Doubles events will advance one class for the remainder of subsequent events in the program. Class winners in Warmup Singles and Doubles will not advance.
10. Shooters should have an up to date ATA Average Card at registration.
11. The State Handicap Champion will automatically earn a minimum of one yard.
12. Events will be shot on a 1 Field Bank System (100 targets per field).
13. Field assignment will be rotated after each event. It is the shooters responsibility to periodically check the board for Squad/Field Assignments.

SHOOT-OFFS

Shoot Management will oversee and referee all shoot-offs. Shoot Management decisions are final.

All Shooters that tie in a preliminary singles or doubles event will have the tie carry over into the following like event until resolved. Ties for Championship Singles (Event 7) and any remaining singles event carry over will shoot off on Saturday. Championship Doubles ties (Event 8) and any remaining doubles event carryover will be determined by shoot-offs on Sunday. All handicap event ties will be determined in shoot-offs the day of the event. Contestants will be called, First Call, Second Call, and Final Call for shoot-offs. No response, shooters will forfeit. All singles & handicap shoot-offs will be on a 25 target basis and doubles will be on 10 pairs.

NOTICES

1. Shells will not be available for sale at the club, so be sure to bring what you may need.
2. If you desire to save your empty hulls, please transfer them from your gun to your pouch. Picking up empty hulls from the ground during and after shooting will not be permitted.
3. Resident winners of the Championship Events are asked to have their photos taken when picking up their trophies for submittal to Trap & Field.

TARGETS & SETTINGS

White Flyer All Orange targets will be thrown for this tournament. The Target Setting Committee will set all targets. Questions concerning target settings will be referred to this committee; its decisions are final.

NO EXCEPTIONS

No soliciting, selling or distribution of shot, shells or any types of goods or wares are allowed on the club premises without the permission of the CGC. Violators will be removed from premises.

REGISTRATION/PRACTICE

1. Capitol Gun Club will open for registration and practice at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday May 24, 2023. The club will also open at 7:00 a.m. daily throughout the shoot; the program will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. on all four days.
2. Practice is restricted to before and after the events.

ATTENDANCE / AWARD PINS

MTA will give attendance pins to each shooter that participates in the 2022 Mississippi State Trap shoot.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

A vendor will be on hand for food during the shoot.

Bottled water will be available on the fields.

ANNOUNCEMENT

This program will absolutely govern the Tournament. The Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern all points not otherwise provided herein. **Shoot Management reserves the right, in its sole discretion, at any time prior to, or during this Tournament to change or modify the program in any manner it deems necessary.**

DISQUALIFICATION

Management reserves the right to refuse any entry or disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner.

STATE MEETING

The Mississippi Trapshooters Association State meeting will be held immediately following the Championship Doubles on Sunday morning. All Mississippi shooters are urged to attend. Location to be announced.

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES

This certifies that Capitol Gun Club has been authorized to hold this registered shoot for the Mississippi Trapshooting Association. ATA Rules will govern this shoot unless otherwise specified, and the scores will be included in the official record.

In addition to the above minimum ATA target requirement, all members of the State Team shall be residents of the State of Mississippi and current members of the Mississippi Trapshooting Association.

MISSISSIPPI TRAPSHOOTING CHAMPTIONSHIPS

Singles & Doubles Classifications

All shooters will be classified on known ability and/or their 16-yard and doubles averages as follows:

SINGLES (Five Classes)

97% and over..... AA
 94% and under 97..... A
 91% and under 94..... B
 88% and under 91..... C
 under 88%..... D

DOUBLES (Five Classes)

93% and over..... AA
 89% and under 93%..... A
 85% and under 89%..... B
 78% and under 85%..... C
 under 78%..... D

Shooters who do not have a total of 1,000 16 yard targets registered in the current and previous year shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the handicap committee.

Shooters who do not have a total of 500 Doubles targets registered in the current and previous year shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the Handicap Committee

HANDICAP CLASSIFICATION

Assigned handicap yardage applies during this tournament. Target requirements for this tournament are at least a total of 1000 handicap targets in the current and previous target year combined. Shooters not meeting target requirements will be penalized as follows: Declared Ladies, Sub-juniors, Juniors, and Veterans shall be penalized one (1) yard beyond current card yardage but not to exceed the 22. All other shooters will be penalized two (2) yards beyond current card yardage not to exceed the 25. Handicap target requirements will be waived for declared Senior Veterans and Chair Shooters. **Known ability may also be applied by the Handicap Committee.**
