TROPHIES: ATA rules will be used to determine winner of ALL TROPHIES. Trophies will not be mailed. Only one trophy per shooter, per event.

CARRY OVERS: Ties for trophies in Singles and Doubles events will be carried over by sub-event to the next like event. Unless specified otherwise, shoot-offs will be for trophies only and will be combined if possible.

SHOOT OFFS: Handicap ties will be shot off daily. Tied shooters will be called 3 times for shoot-offs. A shooter who fails to apear will forfeit. If no shoot-off contestants appear, a winner will be determined by management.

ATA RULES: The Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern all points not otherwise provided.
