INFORMATION SPECIAL CATEGORIES

It is the shooters responsibility to make sure that all special categories (Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veterans, Veterans, and Senior Vets) are declared special category at the time

of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a

category shooter. Without such declaration the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special category after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All-American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (ie. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran.) Chair shooters are exempt from this rule Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Sub Veteran, Veteran, and Senior Veteran must be marked on all entry cards and the bulletin board. Shooters are responsible for seeing that this is done at both places.

All around scores are recorded by the computer, check your scores at the scoreboard. Ties: Shot off at the end of each day, or as otherwise announced. Absentees forfeit. There will be no shootoffs for Friday's class Singles or Doubles. Those ties carryover to Saturday's and Sunday's respective events

MAKING ENTRIES

Have your shoot record card up to date and accurate.

Have your plastic address card with you. Have your entries properly stamped. Know what money you intend to play before you get to the cashiers desk. Keep your classification slip with you.
