RULES GOVERNING THIS TOURNAMENT

- 1. ATA rules will govern this tournament. The line referees and shoot management will interpret and enforce all rules as the ATA has prescribed.
- 2. Junior and Sub-Junior shooters are eligible to shoot for \$30.00/100 which includes targets and trophies provided no options or purses are entered.
- 3. All contestants who enter will be eligible for trophies and added monies, as listed.
- 4. The Handicap Committee reserves the right to reclassify any shooter at any time in accordance with ATA rules. If you earn yardage in the handicap *Friday*, it is *the shooters* responsibility to report to the Classification Committee. Winners and ties in the preliminary Doubles and Singles events <u>will not</u> be advanced a class for Saturday and Sunday Championship events.
- 5. FWTS reserves the right to refuse the entry of, or to disqualify any shooter who in its opinion is interfering with the harmony of the tournament.
- 6. FWTS Club and the Zone IV officers reserve the right to change or cancel any or all of this program.
- 7. Management reserves the right to combine squads on ALL events.
- 8. A squad will be held up to **three (3) minutes** for a tardy shooter. If the tardy shooter does not arrive within three (3) minutes, shooting will begin. The shooter may make up **one (1) trap** on the practice field. Missing more than one (1) trap will require resquadding.
- The Scholarship Lewis options will be split 50% to the shooter and 50% to TTA Scholarship Fund. Support our youth!
- No new purse or option entries or changes permitted after the first score is posted in that event. All options are open to those who enter except as described in Rule #2. OPTION MONEY <u>WILL NOT BE</u> REFUNDED AFTER EVENT HAS BEGUN.
- 11. Category shooters **must declare** their *special category* at time of entry. It is the shooters responsibility!
- 12. A shooter may win only <u>one (1) trophy</u> in any event!

RULES GOVERNING THIS TOURNAMENT (cont....)

- 13. Fort Worth Trap & Skeet Club is **NOT** responsible for any theft or damage to personal property or any accidents.
- 14. **No** picking up of hulls allowed. If you want your empties, put them in your pocket.
- 15. The Zone IV Team at the State Shoot shall be composed of the five (5) Zone IV Singles Class Winners (AA, A, B, C, D). The Zone IV Singles Champion shall represent the Zone at the State Shoot for the Zone Champion Event. Zone Special Category winners will record their scores at the state shoot for bragging rights.
- 16. All added money, if any will be issued by check by FWTS.
- 17. Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of the day's shooting. *<u>Champion winners are not eligible for Class trophies</u>*.
- 18. Targets are set for each event based on ATA rules as per agreement between the target setting committee and the Zone IV officials. They may be checked upon request of a shooter, *but will not be reset unless they become illegal or are markedly different from other trap settings.* Resetting a field is at the target setting committee's discretion.
- <u>Shoot-offs for Events 1, and 3 will carry over</u> to championship events EXCEPT WHEN YARDAGE APPLIES. Championship event ties will be shot off. Event 2 will be shot off.
