

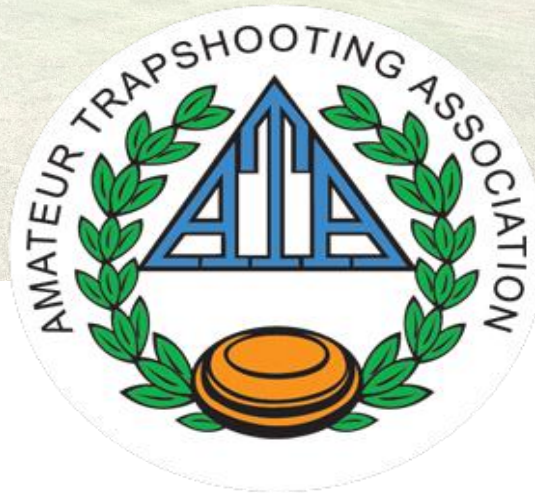

DAY ONE SATURDAY, JUNE 7, 2025

REGISTRATION OPENS AT 8:30am

SHOOTS STARTS AT 9:00am

Entries for all events close at 1:00 P.M.

Fees: ATA & MTA fees are paid once per day **MTA target assessment \$2.00 per event.** \$2.00 fifty straight handicap jackpot 50% paid.
Lewis Option 2 classes, 60% 40% (ties divide) for all events.

Classification: five classes will be used for this two day shoot for Singles and Doubles: Shooters will be classified according to their known ability and must have their current average card and ATA membership card with them to enter.

Singles (5)

AA 97% and over

A 94% and < 97%

B 91% and < 94%

C 88% and < 91%

D Under 88%

Doubles (5)

AA 93% and over

A 89% and < 93%

B 85% and < 89%

C 78% and < 85

D Under 78%

Handicap yardage groups: 19-21.5, 22-24.5, 25-27.

Handicap will be ATA assigned yardage. Any shooter who shoots in a class or handicap yardage that is higher or lower than that which is assigned will be subject to disqualification and are not eligible for trophies or Lewis purse winnings.

Special Categories only apply to Event 4 they are: Sub-Junior (14 years and under), Junior (15-17 years), Lady (Lady I and Lady II are combined), Vet, and Senior Vet may be declared for the 200 singles championship. Juniors and Sub-Juniors may shoot at discount prices for targets and trophies in the 200 singles championship and are not allowed to play options.

Juniors and Sub-Juniors shooting at discount prices may not play options and are not eligible for the fifty straight jackpot.

These categories must be declared at the time of registration, no changes will be made after the shooter has been cashiered.

New Shooters: Shooters that wish to participate in any event in this program may join the ATA at the time of registration. The ATA annual membership is Twenty dollars (\$20.00). Those shooters will be placed in class "B" for singles, and doubles and placed at the 22 yard line for handicap. New shooters may elect to shoot targets only and shoot from the prescribed ATA yardage per ATA rules. They will not be eligible for trophies.

Ammunition: Reloads may be used for this shoot. All ammunition must conform to ATA rules and is subject to inspection at any time. No shot larger than size 7.5 is allowed.

Ties: Ties will be decided by shoot-off or reverse run. Singles and handicap shoot-offs will be fifteen targets (3 shots each station) and doubles will be 20 targets (2 pair each station).

ATA Registered Shoot Certificate

Century Gun Club is a member club in good standing of the Amateur Trapshooting Association, and is authorized to hold an ATA registered trap shoot on the date(s) listed in this program. ATA club number 27-0055.

Directions to the club

From the east / west: take I-94 to exit 187 Rawsonville Rd go south 10 miles (Rawsonville becomes a dirt road) to Newberg Rd. East on Newberg Rd ½ mile to the club. From the north / south take I-275 to exit 8 Will-Carleton Rd. continue west, Will-Carleton becomes Oakville-Waltz Rd. continue 7 miles on Oakville-Waltz Rd to Timbers Rd, Timbers Rd. to Newberg Rd. west on Newberg Rd. to the club.

HOA Champion: Club Trophy to the highest combined score of 400 combined targets from Events 2, 3, and 4. Must shoot all 3 to be eligible. If no one shoots all three events the HOA trophy will not be awarded.

Trophies: will be awarded to the winner of each class in singles, doubles and each yardage group 19-21.5, 22-24.5, 25-27 and are open in Events 1,2, and 3. Category trophies will be awarded for Event 4 only and are open. If a shooter elects to shoot only 100 targets in Event 4, there is no trophy and they will not be eligible for HOA.

MI Zone 5 Singles Class Champions Trophies: These will be provided by the Michigan Trapshooting Association (MTA) for Zone 5 members only. Club trophies will be awarded to Non-Resident Singles Champion and class winners for event 4.

***Minimum 15 entries per event required for awards, club management reserves the right to modify the program.

This is an invitational shoot and the Club Directors reserve the right to reject, refund, or disqualify any contestant who; in their judgment interferes with the harmony of the shoot or violates ATA or safety rules and regulations. ATA rules govern all events and referees will make decisions in accordance with them. **If a shooter is disqualified for any reason no refund will be given.**

There are no refunds unless the event is cancelled by the club.

Waiver and Release Agreement: By attending and paying entry fees to participate in any trap shoot held by or at Century Gun Club (i.e. the “Club”), Carleton, MI, the participants agree to the following
