The shoot format for 2025 will repeat the format used in 2024. Given the recent shift to a greater number of entries in the 16 Yard Event rather than in the Handicap Event and in an effort to provide the best possible lighting conditions for <u>ALL</u> Doubles entrants, the Doubles Event will again be held on <u>SUNDAY</u> immediately following the Handicap Events rather than on Saturday after the 16 Yard Event as it was scheduled several years past.

In addition to making lighting conditions more fair for the Doubles Event it should also allow for better lighting conditions for the 16 Yard shoot-offs and a more relaxed environment for the Shooter Appreciation dinner on Saturday evening.

Obviously in order for this change to succeed, your participation in helping move the Handicap Events along as quickly as possible is just as necessary as it was in the 16 Yard Event in previous years. THANK YOU in advance for your co-operation!!

CLASS HIGH OVER-ALL AWARDS

Determined by the Class you are assigned to in the 16 Yard Event

- SPECIAL CATEGORIES, including "NOVICE CLASS" must be declared <u>verbally</u> at the time of classification. It is the <u>responsibility of the shooter</u> to review his/her classification receipt and ensure that such declaration is correctly noted. In case of an error, the shooter must notify the Tournament Office of the error before firing his/her first shot in an event. A shooter automatically regains his/her eligibility for SPECIAL CATEGORY awards for all events he/she shoots their first target in AFTER the error has been reported and for High Over-All awards if the correction has been made prior to firing his/her first shot in the Doubles Event.
- Shooters with less than 500 targets per event (or 300 for Doubles) in the 2025 and 2026 target years <u>combined</u> are subject to penalty classifications of "B" for the 16 Yard and Doubles Events and Penalty Yardage of their current ATA Yardage PLUS 2 yards for the Handicap Event, <u>MAXIMUM</u> of 25 yards per ATA Rules.
- Classification for the 16 Yard & Doubles Events will be taken from the Shooter's 2025 and 2026 Averages as shown on their 2026 ATA Average Card or equivalent. If you keep your averages in some format OTHER than an ATA Average Card, You MUST make available both your 2025 and 2026 target year counts and averages.
- Shooters are required to have their averages <u>correctly calculated and legibly entered</u> on their average card or equivalent. <u>PLEASE</u> have your average card and plastic membership card ready when reporting for classification and/or squadding. Failure to do so will cause delays in the classification process for yourself as well as other shooters.

PROGRAM NOTES

- This is an invitational tournament and Fulton County Gun Club reserves the authority to reject and refund, or disqualify any contestant who, in its judgment, interferes with the conduct, safety, accuracy or sportsmanship of the shoot.
- 2. In event of a dispute over interpretation of any part of this program, the decision of Fulton County Gun Club shall govern. By entering this tournament, all contestants agree to abide by all rules of the ATA, and to abide by all decisions of Fulton County Gun Club. All situations not specifically covered herein are subject to published rules of the ATA. as interpreted and determined to be applicable by shoot management. Decisions of shoot management shall be FINAL.
- 3. Management reserves the right to change this program as necessary and for the benefit of the entrants in event of conditions beyond its control.
- 4. "ADDED MONEY" shown for Event Champions, Classes, Yardage Groups and Special Categories is <u>GUARANTEED</u> and will be paid as published in this program regardless of the number of entrants (must be 1) in each Class, Yardage Group or Category.
- At least three (3) entrants must enter and complete each event respectively (three (3) total for "open" options or three (3) in each class for "class" options or option money will be refunded.
- Class or Yardage Group will be automatically awarded over category unless
 Tournament Office is directed otherwise <u>IN WRITING</u> within 15 minutes after last squad's scores are posted.
- For award and/or "added money" purposes, shooters having earned yardage in the 1st
 Handicap Event will remain in the yardage group based on their original entering
 yardage but MUST shoot the 2nd 100 from their new yardage.
- All scores are final 15 minutes after the last squad is posted, no scores will be changed after that time and will be reported to the ATA as such.
- 9. Ties for "ADDED MONEY" will be shot off or resolved by shooter agreement at the end of each day's events. No-shows for shoot-offs if opponent(s) report for shootoffs forfeits all claim to trophies. Failure of all contestants to respond by final call for shoot-offs will require management to determine winner by coin flip.
- Shooters who may be tied and included in a shoot off for Event Champion and/or Class or Yardage Group Champions <u>DO NOT</u> forfeit their ability to "fall-back" to Special Category and/or Class or Yardage Group.
- Shoot-offs for 16 Yard and Handicap Events will be sub-events of 25 targets.
 Shoot-offs for Doubles Event will be in sub-events of 10 pair. Shoot-offs for High Over-All will be combined total of 25 x 16 yards + 25 x Handicap + 10 pair of Doubles.
- 12. Shooters included in Handicap or High Over-All shoot-offs will shoot from their <u>LAST ASSIGNED</u> Handicap yardage. Shooters having earned yardage in the 1st Handicap event will shoot-off from the yardage the 2nd Handicap event was shot.


