

2025 Northern Indiana Zone Championships Rules and Regulations

A shooter must be a resident of Indiana and of his or her zone for the six (6) months immediately preceding this tournament in order to be eligible for resident trophies or membership on the Zone Team.

Shooters are required to have their averages correctly calculated and legibly entered on their Average Card. It is the duty of each A.T.A. member to assure that all wins and ties in 16 yd and Doubles events are properly recorded on his or her Average Card. Shooters not having their Average Cards up to date may be placed in a higher class at the discretion of the classification committee (see A.T.A. Rules: Section IV, Article F).

Please have your Average Card (or equivalent) and plastic Membership Card ready when reporting for classification or squading. Failure to do so will cause delays in the classification process.

- A shooter must have 500 registered 16 yard targets for 2024-2025 target years combined or shoot Penalty Class C or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.
- A shooter must have 500 registered Handicap targets for 2024-2025 target years combined or must shoot their ATA yardage plus 2 yard penalty.
- A shooter must have 300 registered Doubles targets for 2024-2025 target years combined or shoot Penalty Class C or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

All targets shot during "Preliminary Day" will count towards qualifying target requirements for Zone Championship Events.

Classes in 16 yd and Doubles events will be determined by the Classification Committee or by using the average on the last 1,000 targets. Members of the I.T.A. Board of Directors shall be in charge of all shoot-offs and awarding of the trophies. They shall certify the assignments to the zone team which shall consist of the high gun of each class (AA-A-B-C-D regardless of category) in the 16 yd Class Championships on Saturday and Double Championships on Sunday. First and Second Alternates shall be the second and third high gun in each class respectively (regardless of category). The Zone team will complete for the State Zone Championship during the 16 yd Championship and doubles Championship events at the 2025 Indiana State Shoot.

Target requirements are waived for Sr. Vet and Lady 2 over 70

If desired by shooters

HANDICAP ENTRY including SPECIAL EVENT FEE must be paid by
10:30 am (local time) and no entries will be accepted by phone
there will be **NO** exceptions.

\$10.00 SPECIAL EVENT FEE does NOT include the \$10.00 MINIMUM BID ON SELF. If
you are not bought by another bidder, you must pay the \$10.00 MINIMUM BID ON
SELF or the final bid amount if higher to buy yourself at the time of the auction.

The SPECIAL EVENT AUCTION will begin **IMMEDIATELY** upon completion of
the Doubles Event and will proceed until completion. This will be a VERBAL AUCTION,
therefore your cooperation in keeping delays in the auction process to a minimum is
appreciated.

Due to the large number of expected entries and management's desire
to expedite the beginning of the Handicap Event in order to provide the best possible
lighting and shooting conditions for all entrants, the first six Handicap Squads are
reserved for those shooters choosing NOT to participate in the Special Event Option.

TROPHIES AND OPTIONS – PROGRAM NOTES**

- All trophies and added monies listed are guaranteed and will be awarded regardless of the number of entrants (must be at least 1) in each Class, Yardage Group and/or Special Category.
- Ties for all trophies and added money will be shot off at the end of each day, respectively. "No shows" for shoot-offs forfeit rights to trophies, added money and assignment to the State Zone Team.
- Ties for 2nd and/or 3rd place(s) in the Championship 16 yard event and Doubles will be shot off or resolved to contestant's satisfaction at the end of the day's event in order to determine the alternate and second alternate to represent the Northern Zone Team at the State Shoot at the end of the days events.
- All other Options and Purses (including Special Event) will divide prize money equally between tied scores.
- ATA rules for trophies will apply - if you have declared any special category and do not win the event, you must accept the category trophy if you have the winning category score.
- If you do not win or tie in category but your score will qualify for a class or yardage group win, you may accept that award and added money.
- Resident Handicap Champion is not eligible for Yardage Group added money or trophies.
- All scores are final 15 minutes after the last squad is posted and will be forwarded to the A.T.A. as such. NO SCORES will be changed after that time. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Team trophies will be awarded to Champion & Runner up teams for Junior, Sub-Jr & Jr Gold. Teams must be declared at registration or at time of pre-squadding. NO changes can be made after registration. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Teams members NEED NOT be a resident of the Indiana Northern Zone to be eligible for the team trophies.

An eligible team shall consist of at least 4 and not more than 5 members shooting on the same squad at the same time.

For team trophy purposes only:

Teams will be classified according to their oldest shooter's category.

For example: a team consisting of at least 1 Jr Gold shooter will only be eligible for the Jr Gold team trophies.

A team consisting of at least 1 Junior and NO Jr Gold shooters will only be eligible for the Junior team trophies.

A Sub Jr team must consist of all Sub Jr shooters to be eligible for Sub Jr team trophies.

Classification of teams is for Special Trophy purposes only and does not affect the individuals ATA classification or ability to win individual trophies.

The HOST CLUB is required to forward \$2.00 for each Resident Handicap event entry to the I.T.A. to help defray the cost of the Zone trophies provided by ITA.
