- Comply with all ATA safety rules in ATA rulebook
- Keep it Safe! Keep it Open! Guns must be OPEN and UNLOADED at all times when off the firing line and when changing stations during an event.
- Treat every gun as if loaded; keep barrel pointed safely.
- Contestants <u>must</u> wear eye and hearing protection.
- Anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be allowed to participate.
- Contestants are not to travel beyond the 16 yard line at any time.
- Spectators are not to enter the shooting field at any time.
- No Alcohol allowed on the premises
- Only approved trap help in the trap houses.
- Management reserves the right to change or alter program.
- Not responsible for theft.

#### Claim of Errors

- All shooters must be ATA & ISTA members to shoot registered events. Entrants may join organizations at the shoot.
- The management reserves the right to refuse the entry of or reject, refund or disqualify any contestant who, in its judgment, interferes with the conduct, accuracy or sportsmanship of the shoot.
- Claim of errors in score must be corrected by the end of each 5 targets when the score of each shooter will be read.
