Qualification Requirements

To assure classification and handicapping, a specific number of targets must be shot in 2024 and 2025 combined with a certain minimum of them in 2025, prior to July 24th, 2025.

Penalty Classes and Handicap yardage

Those not meeting the target requirements shall be assigned penalty class and yardage as follows:

PENTALTY YARDAGE

Your current ATA assigned yardage plus a minimum of two (2) yards to a maximum of 26.5 yards. Penalty yardage is waived for Senior Veterans. Earned yardage awarded will be based on the number of shooters at each individual location, not the total of all locations.

Special Categories

It is the shooters responsibility to make sure that all special categories (Lady 1, Lady 2, Sub-Jr, Junior, Junior G, Sub-Vet, Vet, and SR Vets) are declared at the time of classification any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special category after firing his or her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. At all tournaments where All American points are awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category. However, chair shooters are exempt from the above rule. The category for the shooter must be marked on the entry forms and the bulletin board. Shooters are responsible for seeing that this is done at both places. All Around scores are recorded by the software, check your scores at the scoreboard. Ties for handicap will be shot off at the end of the day, singles and doubles will be carry over. These ties will carry over into Saturday's 16 and Sunday's Doubles.

Registered Shoot Participants

Please have your average card accurate and up to date. Have your plastic card with you at registration. Know what money you intend to play before you get to the cashiers window. No entries refunded unless the event is canceled.
