The members of our Handicapping and Classification Committee shall act as judges for any controversy between a contestant and a score-puller, etc.

No entry may be changed after the events start.

Should a shooter win or tie in any class event, it shall be the shooter's duty to report to the Handicapping and Classification Committee to have his/her classification changed.

Shells and camping space will be available on the grounds. The sale of shells, trap loads by any other person or company will not be allowed.
