

Club Location and Directions

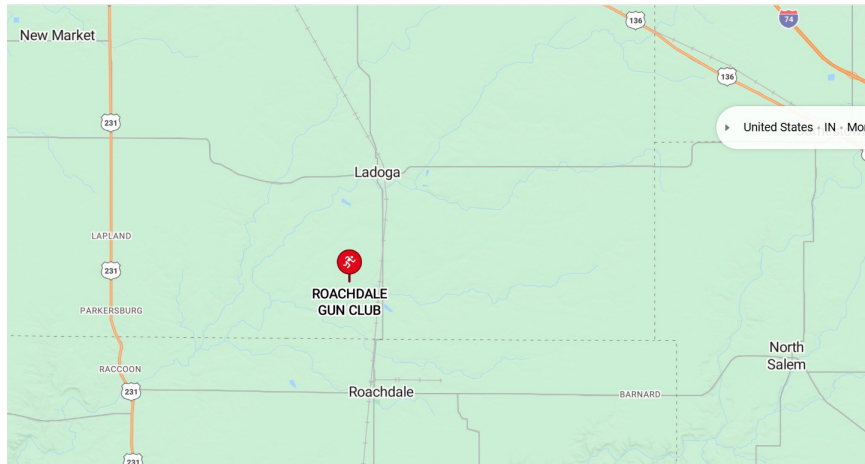

From the North

1. Take US-231 S toward Ladoga/Roachdale.
2. Near Ladoga, merge onto IN-67 S (also Washington St through Ladoga).
3. Continue as it becomes CR 550 E past the railroad tracks.
4. After about 2 miles south of Ladoga, turn right (west) onto 1100 S—you'll pass under a railroad overpass.
5. The gun club is on the north side of this road about 1 mile west of the turn.

From the South (Roachdale)

1. Take CR 550 E (Washington St) north toward Ladoga.
2. Pass through Roachdale and cross railroad tracks. 2 miles north of town, turn left (west) on 1100 S under the overpass.
3. Drive about 1 mile west; the club is on the north side.

CLASS HIGH OVER-ALL AWARDS

Determined by the Class you are assigned to in the 16 Yard Event

- SPECIAL CATEGORIES, must be declared verbally at the time of classification. It is the responsibility of the shooter to review his/her classification receipt and ensure that such declaration is correctly noted. In case of an error, the shooter must notify the Tournament Office of the error before firing his/her first shot in an event. A shooter automatically regains his/her eligibility for SPECIAL CATEGORY trophies for all events he/she shoots their first target in AFTER the error has been reported and for SPECIAL CATEGORY High Over-All awards if the correction has been made prior to firing his/her first shot in the Handicap Event.
- Shooters with less than 500 targets per event (300 targets for Doubles) in the 2025 and 2026 target years combined are subject to penalty classifications of "B", subject to known ability, for the 16 Yard and Doubles Events and Penalty Yardage of their current ATA Yardage PLUS 2 yards for the Handicap Event, Maximum of 25 yards per ATA Rules.
- Classification for the 16 Yard & Doubles Events will be taken from the Shooter's 2025 and 2026 averages as shown on their 2026 ATA Average Card or equivalent. If you keep your averages in some format other than an ATA Average Card, You must make both your 2025 and 2026 target year counts and averages available at classification.
- Please have your average card and plastic membership card ready when reporting for classification and/or squadding.

Notes and Information

- Ties for trophies in each event will be shot off at the end of each day's shooting.
- Category shooters must take category champion over class/yardage group. If shooter does not win their category they may fall back to their class/yardage group.
- No-shows for shoot-offs if opponent(s) reports for shoot-off forfeit claim to trophies.
- Failure of all tied contestants to respond to call for shoot-offs will require management to determine winner by coin flip.
- Shoot-offs for 16 Yard and Handicap Events will be sub-events of 25 targets. Shoot-offs for Doubles Event will be in sub-events of 10 pair.
- Shoot-offs for High Over-All will be combined total of 25 x 16 yards + 10 pair of Doubles + 25 x Handicap shoot-off targets.
- All options will be divided equally. All scores are final 15 minutes after the last squad is posted, no scores will be changed after that time and scores will be forwarded to the ATA as such.
- All option money not picked up by the end of the shoot will be mailed.
