All added money is awarded with trophy and ties for added money do not divide.

### **Qualification Requirements**

To assure equitable classification and handicapping, a specific number of minimum targets must be shot in 2025 and 2026 combined with a certain minimum of targets being shot in 2026 target year, prior to July 25, 2026.

### **Penalty Classes and Handicap Yardage**

Those not meeting the target requirements shall be assigned penalty class and yardage as follows.

	Total in 25/26	Minimum 2026	Class/Ydgs
Singles	800	400	Class A
Handicap	800	400	See Below
Doubles	400	200	Class B

For Ladies and Sub-Juniors, the minimum shall be Class B in Singles and Class C in Doubles respectively.

**NOTE: PENALTY YARDAGE WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: YOUR CURRENT ATA ASSIGNED YARDAGE PLUS A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) YARDS TO A MAXIMUM OF 25 YARDS.**

Example: Shooter A: ATA assigned yardage is 22 yards, plus the two (2) yard penalty; The shooter shoots from the twenty-four (24) yard line. Shooter B: ATA assigned yardage is 24 yards, plus a one (1) yard penalty, shooter shoots from the twenty-five (25) yard line. Penalty yardage is waived for Senior Veterans.

98% and over ..... AAA  
96.25% and under 98% ..... AA  
94.75% and under 96.25% ..... A  
93% and under 94.75% ..... B  
90% and under 93% ..... C  
Under 90% ..... D

### **Doubles Classification**

96% and over ..... AAA  
92% and under 96% ..... AA  
89% and under 92% ..... A  
86% and under 89% ..... B  
82% and under 86% ..... C

Under 82% ..... D

SPTS Trophies: Open - Winner each class (AAA, AA, A, B, C, D); Winner each category (Lady, Veteran, Sr Vet, Junior/Sub Jr). Must have 3 entries each for full payout.

Earned yardage awarded will be based on number of shooters at SPTS, not all Central Zone sites. All winners and ties in each Class will be moved up a Class for Saturday's Singles and Sunday's Doubles events.

### SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

It is the shooters responsibility to make sure that all special categories (Lady I, Lady II, Sub Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veteran, and Senior Vet) are declared special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special category after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veteran, and Senior Vet). Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

Lady I, Lady II, Sub Junior, Junior, Junior, Sub Veteran, Veteran, Senior Vet must be Sunday, July 26, 2026

Registration opens at 8:30 a.m. Program start time 9:30 AM. A \$4.00 ATA daily fee, a \$1.00 ATA daily Central Zone fee and \$3.00 WTA daily fee will be charged.

SPTS Trophies: Open - Winner each class (AAA, AA, A, B, C, D); Winner each category (Lady, Veteran, Sr Vet, Junior/Sub Jr). Must have 3 entries each for full payout.

SPTS Trophies: Open - Champion; Winner each Yardage Group (19-21, 22-24, 25-27). Winner each category (Lady, Veteran, Sr Vet, Junior/Sub Jr). Must have 3 entries each for full payout.

### Event #7. High Over All on Events 1-6 (700 Targets), based on classification in Event #1.

SPTS Trophies: Open - Champion.

**Ties:** Shot off at the end of the day, or as otherwise announced. Absentees forfeit. There will be no shoot-offs for Friday's Class Singles or Class Doubles. These ties will carry-over to Saturday's Singles and Sunday's Doubles Events respectively.
