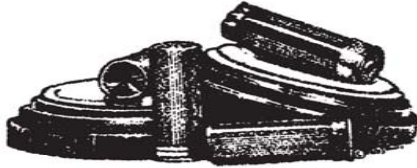

GENERAL INFORMATION

A.T.A. rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All targets are registered. Nebraska shooters must have a 2026 annual NTA membership (\$10.00), unless they are a lifetime member of NTA (\$150.00). Memberships will be available at the shoot. Shooters must also have a current ATA membership. A daily ATA fee of \$4.00 will be charged. NTA Fees of \$2.00 included in the target pricing.

BANK SYSTEM

The bank system will be used for the 2026 state shoot. We will start eleven banks on all events. Banks will be drawn and posted each day. You will need to check the posted bank sheets. Some squads may not be filled. **The PA system will NOT be used to call shooters!**

Be ready to shoot. **A SQUAD BOARD WILL NOT BE USED. SQUADS WILL NOT WAIT FOR TARDY MEMBERS.** Per ATA rules (Section VII Par. A, 6 states: "A shooter that misses the first post in any event may make up that post only and continue with the squad. Squad members should move off the line during the shoot up function." If you miss more than one post, report to the office.

QUIET TIME IS 10:00 PM TO 6:30 AM.

This is an invitational tournament and the Directors of the NTA reserve the right to reject, refund or disqualify any contestant who, in its judgment, interferes with the conduct, accuracy or sportsmanship of the shoot. In event of a dispute over interpretation of any part of this program, the decision of the Directors shall govern. By entering the tournament contestants agree to abide by all rules of the ATA and NTA and abide by all decisions of the Directors.

The Directors of the NTA reserve the right to post-pone, cancel or change any part of the program due to bad weather or other causes.

Practice Traps will be open daily starting one hour before the program starts.

Purchase your tickets at the office!

Classification and entry windows will be open Tuesday at 8:00 a.m. and daily at 8:00 a.m.

CLASSIFICATION

Penalty yardage and class will be required when a shooter has not met the minimum requirements or the Classification Committee determines the average does not reflect the shooter's true ability.

Any shooter who has not shot the following number of registered targets in 2025 and/or 2026 prior to June 22, 2026 will be classified as follows.

If you have NOT shot **You will be classified or handicapped**

MALE SHOOTER 18 YRS. and over, including JUNIOR GOLD and SUB VETERAN*

1000	16-yard targets	Class A or higher
1000	Handicap targets	24 yds. or more
500	Doubles targets	Class B or higher

MALE JUNIOR SHOOTER*

1000	16-yard targets	Class B or higher
1000	Handicap targets	24 yds. or more
500	Doubles targets	Class B or higher

LADY I and LADY II, SUB JUNIOR and VETERANS*

700	16-yard targets	Class B or higher
700	Handicap targets	22 yds. or more
300	Doubles targets	Class B or higher

SENIOR VETERANS will not be required to shoot penalty yardage or class.

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to change the shooter's classification at any time.

Classification will be according to known ability. To arrive at known ability, the following will be taken into account as far as such information will be available:

Official averages (abnormally low scores will be disregarded)

- Non-registered scores, including shoot-off scores; non-registered events; practice scores, etc.
- Any other information known on shooter's ability to shoot and break targets.

Averages must be calculated on card prior to sign-up* or shooter will shoot penalty Class A or higher.

***AGE CLASSIFICATION FOR CATEGORY as of 9/1/2025**

Lady I	= up to age 55
Lady II	= 55 and over
Sub-Veteran	= 55 through age 64
Veteran	= 65 up to age 70
Sr. Veteran	= 70 and older
Junior	= 15 up to age 18
Junior Gold	= 18 up to age 23
Sub-Junior	= Up to age 15

Singles Classification

Class AAA98% and over
Class AA96.25% and under 98%
Class A94.75% and under 96.25%
Class B93% and under 94.75%
Class C90% and under 93%
Class Dunder 90 %

Doubles Classification

Class AAA96% and over
Class AA92% and under 96%
Class A89% and under 92%
Class B86% and under 89%
Class C82% and under 86%
Class Dunder 82%

Both Resident and Non-Resident high scores in class in the singles and doubles events will be advanced one class for the remainder of the shoot. Any shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason shall be considered to have been notified when the new class or yardage is posted.

Once any category declarations have been made either by a shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.

Any shooter who has declared a special category, will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage. If the special category shooter does not qualify for a trophy in his/her category, he/she is eligible to compete for place, class or yardage

The intent of the NTA regarding the winning of trophies is that no shooter may win more than one trophy per event. Exceptions are in Event #10 (Zone Champion), Event #11 (Past President, Two Generations, AIM awards, Zone Champion and Zone Team), Event #12 (Zone Champion, Hall of Fame Award and Life Member).

A Sub-Junior cannot win a Junior award. A Junior cannot win a Junior Gold Award, a Sub Veteran can-not win a Veteran Award and a Veteran cannot win a Sr. Veteran award.

AIM Youth Shooters

Both resident and non-resident AIM youth shooters will be able to compete for AIM medals and awards in the Doubles Championship on June 26, Singles Championship on June 27, and Handicap Championships on June 28. AIM shooters should enter with AIM Director Wyatt Kile before the events has started for each event.

AIM youth shooters are required to have current ATA , AIM, and NTA memberships to shoot for AIM awards. Shamrock has graciously donated a 8 box leather bag to Nebraska State AIM Shoot. The bag will be given away by drawing a number at the end of singles Championship Event. The tying score will shoot off for the bag.

Eye and Ear protection in accordance with ATA Rules, Section IV Par. I, 16 will be enforced. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from that event.

HOW TO ENTER

1. Report to the Classification Committee in the Clubhouse. Have your ATA card, NTA sticker and score card ready. **NOTE: IF YOUR SCORE CARD IS NOT UP TO DATE AND AVERAGED. PENALTY YARDAGE and/or CLASS MAY BE APPLIED.**
2. If you have pre-squadded, go directly to the window marked for pre-squad shooters. Pick your options and pay your shooting fees. You can now relax and enjoy the shoot with your trapshooting friends.
3. If you have NOT pre-squadded, determine what options you want to play for each event and proceed to one of the cashiers' window to be squadded and pay your shooting fees. **Options cannot be added or deleted after an event begins.**
4. **Number of squads will be limited on each bank.**
5. **It is the responsibility of Ladies I & II, Sub-Veterans, Veterans, Senior Veterans, Juniors, Junior Gold and Sub-Juniors to see that they are so indicated on their entry forms if they want to shoot for category. Category must be entered prior to shooting your first competitive target of the shoot.**
6. All information needed for awards, added money, and reporting to ATA are taken from the computer print-outs. Be sure all data posted is correct. All information will stand as posted unless the contestant is disqualified.
7. **During peak sign-up periods entries may be taken for that day's events only! ON TUESDAY MORNING, ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN FOR TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY'S EVENTS ONLY.**
8. We will be accepting credit card payments for targets, options and purses. There will be an added service charge based on the current rate on total amount charged. Service charge rate will be posted at the windows.
9. **If a shooter misses his or her squad or wants to change squads, there will be a \$20.00 resquadding fee per post.**

GOLF CARTS, BIKES, ATV's, etc

THE USE OF THIS TYPE OF VEHICLE IS LIMITED TO THE AREA BEHIND (SOUTH OF) THE SIDEWALK AT ALL TIMES & ARE PROHIBITED ON THE HAY FIELDS NORTH OF THE TRAP HOUSES. At no time should they be used between the sidewalk and the shooting range or on the sidewalk during a shooting event. The exception is use by shoot management to run the shoot. The NTA and shoot management are not responsible for any accidents resulting from the use of such vehicles!

All Golf/ Utility Carts to be used on the NTA home grounds at 502 N. 1st, Doniphan, must be registered with the NTA. You must maintain insurance limits of \$100,000, combine single limits (CSL). Proof of insurance must be submitted to Joy by email (jtrim@vcn.com) or delivered to the NTA office during the State Shoot. This must be completed before the Golf/ Utility Cart can be used.

The top ten awards take precedence over a category award. Up to a limit of five members will be recognized per category if their average is within five percent of the top average in the category.

The category designation for the All-State Team will be your age the first day of the previous trapshooting year.

2027 HALL OF FAME

At the January meeting, the Board of Directors decided to postpone the Hall of Fame Event to the 2027 State Shoot. Nominations can be emailed to Joy Trim. The Hall of Fame Committee is: Toney Krajewski, John Burke and Richard Scheer.

CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP: Active Shooter: male or female; may be deceased. Associate Member: male or female; may be a shooter or non-shooter; may be deceased.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SHOOTING MEMBERS: 1. A minimum of ten years of ATA registered trapshooting in the State of Nebraska. 2. At least 25,000 registered ATA singles targets. 3. Major items for determination of qualification for the Hall of Fame: a. One State Championship from among the Nebraska State Singles, Handicap, Doubles, High-All-Around, or High-Over-All. b. Major ATA wins (including Grand American, Satellite Grand, ATA Zone, etc.) c. Member of the ATA All America Team. d. Ten or more years as a member of a Nebraska All State Team, including the top ten shooters and subcategories. e. Significant accomplishments in international trapshooting.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSOCIATE MEMBERS: 1. A minimum of ten years of ATA registered trapshooting in the State of Nebraska. 2. At least 25,000 registered ATA singles targets. 3. Ten years of work supporting shooting in the State, such as: serving as an NTA Officer, ATA Delegate, Gun Club Owner, Operator, Worker, etc., or through extensive involvement in special programs that can include activities such as youth training, league management, etc.

The sport of trapshooting in Nebraska encompasses great individuality and diversity. The Board of Directors, therefore, may modify the letter, but not the spirit of the above criteria to accommodate special circumstances. Major wins outside the State of Nebraska are important and should be given some consideration. They should not, however, be used to meet the minimum requirements for membership. The name is The Nebraska Trapshooting Hall of Fame and the requirements should be met in Nebraska!! Target and performance requirements may be relaxed in cases of death, incapacitation, disability or other circumstances.

The State Singles Champion, Lady I, Lady II, Junior Gold, Junior, Sub-Junior, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, and Sr. Veteran Winners in Event #9, the Nebraska Singles Championship, will each be awarded \$150.00 provided they attend the 2025 Grand American Trapshoot and shoot in the Champion of Champions Event. If they do not attend, the runners-up will receive that amount, provided they attend. If neither attends, the money reverts to the NTA. **To determine Champion of Champion Alternates (2nd and 3rd places) will be decided by reverse 25's if not determined already by shoot offs.**

Winners must notify the NTA Secretary in writing of their intentions to attend the Grand American by July 15th, 2026.

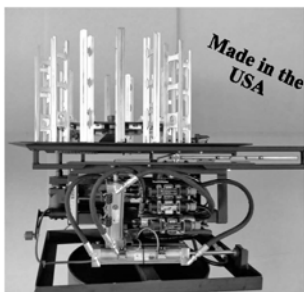

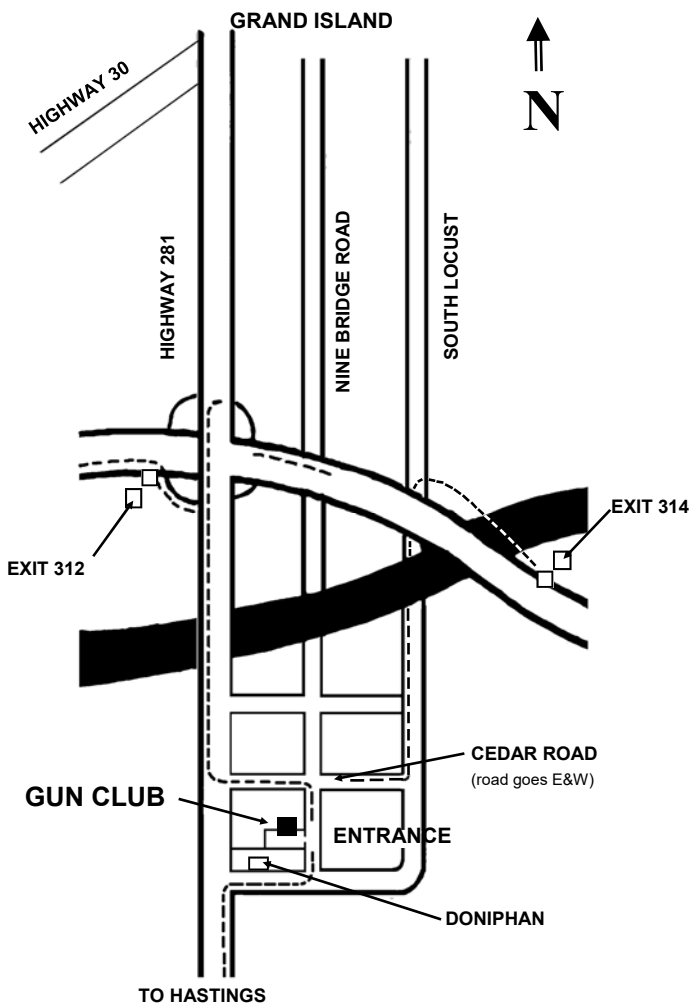

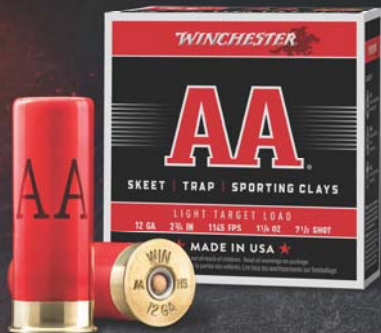
