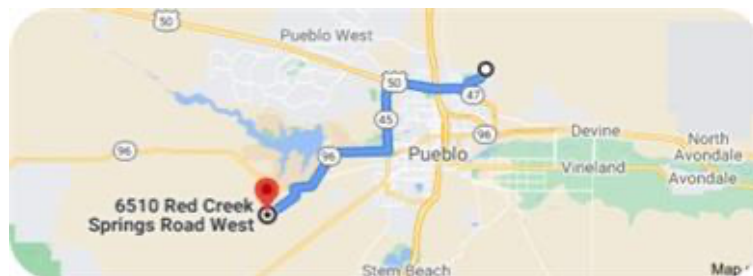

All purses and options are non-compulsory. Shoot-offs for ties will be held after last event each day. Runner-up trophies will be awarded if there are a minimum of three shooters per class or yardage. All cash payouts will be mailed – prizes given out at the event.

Special category prizes for Ladies, Sr. Vet, Vet and Juniors. Category shooters must be declared at sign up and will only be eligible for category prizes. Sr. Vets who choose to shoot the entire program on Sunday (500 birds) should register as a Vet. Juniors not playing options may shoot for \$34.00 per 100 targets. \*If there is not a minimum of two shooters per category, shooters will revert to their class.

Special event will be held during lunch after Event One 70 percent buyer, 30 percent shooter. All ties are split. Payout: 60/40.
