In the event of multiple
500 straights, bounty
will be divided.

100,200,300,400 Straight Bounty

\$100, \$200, \$300 & \$400 bounties have been set aside
for each event with a perfect score shot from the front.

Multiple perfect scores will divide the bounty.

A shooter is only eligible to be paid for their longest run.

(For example a lone 200 straight pays \$200, and two 200 straights divide \$200.)

A shooter could miss their 1st target, run 499/500 and not take home this money.)

Bounty for Youth Shooters

Any JR. shooter may earn money for perfect scores

50 Straight pays \$20

75 Straight pays \$30

100 Straight pays \$40

A shooter is only eligible to be paid for their longest run.
