Marvin mentored two of his grandsons, Kyle and Justin Grummert, both of whom had success in ATA and high school tournaments. Marvin also co-coached the Lincoln Northstar High School Trap Team for ten years. Roger Hudson, who coached with Marvin, described him this way: "Like most of us, he didn't ever win the Grand American, but he was a good ol' boy who loved guns and helped a lot of kids." Marvin's family has generously donated to shooting sports at this club, and the ECTC, so that Marvin's legacy will continue.
