- ENTRY PROCEDURE -

1. Present your plastic and paper average card to Classification.
2. Shooter's responsibility to ensure average card is correct and up to date to avoid possible disqualification, forfeiture of trophies, monies and further disciplinary action by the ATA.
3. Your plastic card is needed for squadding and cashiering.
4. After squadding proceed to the cashier.
5. The Starting Traps will be determined by drawing a number immediately before each event. After an event has started, the squadding committee shall fill any squad or position on a first available basis.
6. Make all checks payable to WVATA. A stamp will be available

By the act of classifying and participating, each shooter becomes a guest and indicates they assume and accept full responsibility for themselves and their minor children, for bodily injury, death, or loss of personal property and expenses as a result of inherent risks and dangers.

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE

This certifies that the WVATA has been authorized to conduct a registered shoot June 13-14, 2026, at the Leetown Gun Club Kearneysville, WV

ATTN: Category Shooters

All Ladies, Sub-Juniors, Juniors, Junior-Golds, Sub-Vets, Veterans, Senior-Vets, and Chair Shooters must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. If a classification error is discovered BEFORE the close of an event, the error shall be corrected for that event and all subsequent events. If an error is discovered AFTER an event is closed, all corrections shall be made for subsequent events only. In either case, all previous events the shooter shot in will be in the "Open Category". Either case may or may not affect the shooters eligibility for the HOA and HAA, depending on when the error was corrected. Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry-over for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the championship trophy shoot-off/carry-over and has declared a special category at the time of classification, the shooter can fall back to the declared category. Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score qualifies for any trophy in his/her declared category, will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group. Any special category shooter, whose score does not qualify for a trophy in his/her Category, may compete for place, class or yardage group trophies.

WEST VIRGINIA AMATEUR TRAPSHOOTING ASSOCIATION

GENERAL INFORMATION AND SHOOT RULES

1. WV and ATA rules will govern this shoot. The WVATA reserves the right to reject or disqualify any entrant, or modify the program should attendance, weather or any other reason make it advisable.
2. Any shooter missing a squad or changing squads for any reason other than earned yardage shall be assessed a \$20.00 resquadding charge. No entries refunded unless the event is cancelled.
3. To be eligible for added money one must have registered 1200 singles targets, 1200 handicap targets and 1200 doubles targets during the current/previous two target years.
4. No shooter may win more than one trophy in the same event. (Exceptions: concurrent special awards)
5. Food and shells will be available on the grounds. Unauthorized sale of these items on the grounds is prohibited.
6. Management will not be responsible for errors in scores after the options have been posted. Shooters should check the scoreboard for their scores and notify management immediately if a discrepancy is noticed. **SCORES BECOME FINAL 1/2 HOUR AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE EVENT.**
7. Trophy winners must pick up trophies before leaving the grounds or make other arrangements. **NO TROPHIES WILL BE SHIPPED.**
8. Earned yardage, class change-advancement posted on the bulletin board shall be considered shooter notification and reminder of their responsibility.
9. Any squad positions not paid 1/2 hour before the cut-off time for each event will be given out to the next available shooter. **Please note cut-off times for each event.**
