Dear Shooters

Welcome to Fulton County Gun Club for the Memorial Weekend calendar of ATA Registered events. If you are one of the many shooters who regularly enjoy the events here, we thank you for your continued support. Should this be your first time here, we appreciate your patronage in advance and hope to earn your favor and become the club of choice for your shooting activities in the future.

Saturday May 23rd, will start the weekend with the Doubles Classic, an event created especially for Doubles shooters. This will be the 25th time that this yearly event has been held, and hopefully, enjoyed by all who have participated. Silver belt buckles will be awarded to Doubles Champion and Runner-Up. The remaining shooters with the top 4 scores posted in each of 5 classes (AA-A-B-C-D) will have the opportunity to become Class Champions in a unique SHOOT-OFF format. Shooters declaring a "category" will be allowed to shoot-off for class championship still fall back to category if not successful in the class shoot-offs.

Trophies will also be awarded to Special Category Champions: Lady, Junior, Veteran and Senior Veteran. The format will find all entrants shooting their first 50 pair across 2 traps, then "turning the wheel" and shooting the second 50 pair across the remaining 2 traps. Total scores on the 200 (100 pair) will be tabulated, Champion and Runner-Up determined and the shoot-off format for Class Champions will begin.

In addition there will be a 100 target Handicap Championship event immediately following the completion of shoot-offs for the Doubles Event. The Handicap Event will find trophies presented to the Champions in each of 4 yardage groups (19-21, 22-24, 25-26 and 27 yards) and Special Category Champions: Lady, Junior, Veteran and Senior Veteran.

Sunday May 24th will be our "regular" Sunday ATA program consisting of 100 16 Yard targets, 100 Handicap targets and 50 Pair of Doubles. Target cost will be \$30.00 per 100 (plus ATA/ITA Daily Fees) with \$2.00 of each entry paid back as "AWARD MONEY" to Class, Yardage Group and Special Category Champions.

Monday May 26th will be an event in the same format as our "regular" Sunday event, consisting of 100 x 16 Yard targets, 100 Handicap targets and 50 Pair of Doubles. Target cost will be \$30.00 per 100 (plus ATA/ITA Daily Fees) with \$2.00 of each entry paid back as "AWARD MONEY" to Class, Yardage Group and Special Category Champions.

Special Categories

JUNIOR ... has not yet attained 18th birthday (*)

LADY

VETERAN ... 65 years of age and not yet 70 (*)

SR VETERAN ... 70 years of age and older (*)

(*) As of Saturday May 23rd, 2026

NOTE: Shooters who become eligible for new age-based categories during the target year may elect to continue in the previous category for the remainder of the target year. Once a shooter has elected to and competed in the new category, they are no longer eligible for the previous category.

Classification Notes

Special Categories must be declared verbally at the time of Classification. It is the responsibility of each individual shooter to review his/her classification receipt and assure that such declaration is correctly noted. In case of an error, the shooter must notify the Tournament Office of the error before firing his/her first shot in the event.

Shooters with less than 300 Doubles targets in the 2025 and 2026 Target Years combined are subject to penalty classification of "B", subject to known ability. Shooters with less than 300 Handicap targets in the 2025 and 2026 Target Years combined are subject to penalty yardage of their current ATA handicap yardage **PLUS** 2 yards. **HOWEVER**, per ATA rules, "PENALTY YARDAGE shall not exceed 25 yards or current yardage, whichever is **GREATER**".

Classification for this tournament will be taken from the shooter's 2025 and 2026 averages as shown on their 2026 ATA average card(s) or equivalent.

Shooters are required to have their averages correctly calculated and legibly entered on their average card or equivalent. It is the duty of each shooter to assure that all wins and ties in 16 Yard and Doubles events are properly recorded on his/her average card or equivalent. **PLEASE** have your average card(s), or equivalent, and plastic membership card ready when reporting for classification and/or squadding. Failure to do so will cause delays in the classification process.

Doubles Classic Program Notes

**The Doubles Event will consist of 100 pair of targets
(200 total) thrown across all 4 traps
(25 pair per trap x 2 flights).**

Ties for Doubles awards will be shot off at the end of the Doubles event. Ties for Handicap awards will be shot off at the end of the Handicap event. No-shows for shoot-offs forfeit claim to Trophies. No-show of all tied contestants will require shoot management to determine winners via coin flip. All other options and purses will be divided equally between contestants with tied scores. All scores are final 15 minutes after the last squad is posted, no scores will be changed after that time and will be forwarded to the ATA as posted.

Shoot-offs (if required) for Champion and Runner-Up will be held immediately after the tabulation of scores has been completed. By competing and subsequently losing a shoot-off to determine Champion or Runner-Up, a shooter will **NOT** forfeit his/her right to shoot off for Class Champion. The Champion and Runner-Up may NOT compete for Class or Special Category awards.

Following shoot-offs (if required) for Champion and Runner-Up, the top 4 scores posted in each class (AA-A-B-C-D), will shoot off within each class to determine Class Champions. By competing and subsequently losing a shoot-off to determine Class Champion, a shooter does NOT forfeit his/her right to win outright or shoot off for a Special Category Champion.

Special Category Champions will be determined upon total score for the 100 pair of Doubles targets. Shoot-offs will be held in the case of ties.

All Doubles shoot-offs will consist of rounds of 10 pairs of Doubles targets, 2 pairs per position. Handicap shoot-offs will be rounds of 25 targets. There is no additional charge for shoot-off targets.

Awards shown for Event Champion, Event Runner-Up, Class & Yardage Group Champions and Special Categories are guaranteed and will be awarded regardless of the number of entrants (must be 1) in each Class or Special Category.

Prize money will be paid immediately following completion of prize calculations.

All situations not specifically covered herein are subject to applicable published rules of the A.T.A. as interpreted by shoot management.

Decisions of shoot management are FINAL.

Comparison of scores by sub-event from the beginning or: b.) Long Run by target count from the beginning.

All other options and purses will be divided equally between contestants with tied scores. All scores are final 15 minutes after the last squad is posted, no scores will be changed after that time and will be forwarded to the ATA as posted.

All other ties for "AWARD MONEY" will be resolved by: a.) comparison of scores by sub-event from the beginning or: b.) long run by target count from the beginning.

All other options and purses will be divided equally between contestants with tied scores. All scores are final 15 minutes after the last squad is posted, no scores will be changed after that time and will be forwarded to the ATA as posted.

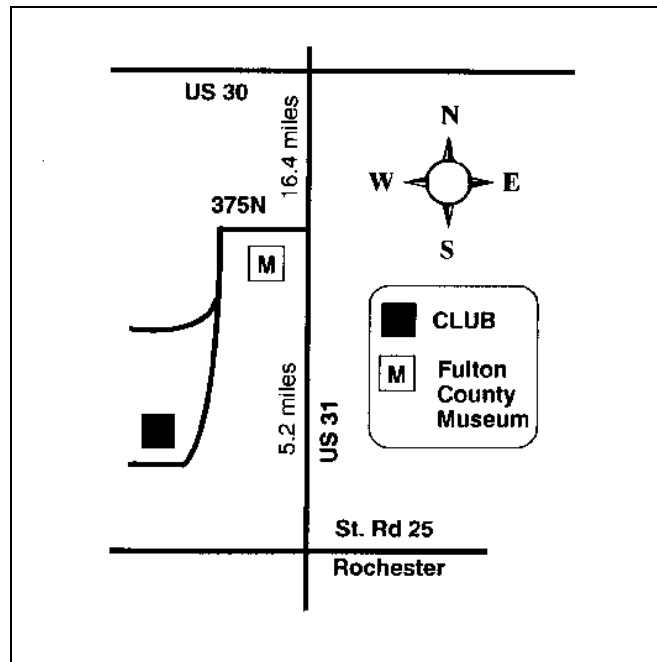
