Dear Shooters

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Fulton County Gun Club on the beautiful banks of the Tippecanoe for the 2026 Northern Indiana Zone Championships. If you are one of the many shooters who regularly enjoy the events here, we thank you for your continued support. Should this be your first time here, we appreciate your patronage in advance and hope to earn your favor and become the club of choice for your shooting activities in the future. If you are new to the club, please take a minute to introduce yourself and feel free to seek any assistance necessary from myself or any one of the many staff members available this weekend for your convenience.

The weekend will start with three Preliminary Day Events on Friday May 29th; 100 x 16 Yard Event beginning at 11:00 am followed by 100 x Handicap and 50 Pair of Doubles. Classification for Saturday and Sunday's Championship events will open at 1:00 pm on Friday.

Saturday's 16 Yard Championship event will be shot in 2 consecutive sub-events of 25 targets each on one trap, 5 per post. Shooters will then move to the next trap for two more sub-events of 25 targets each. Squads will alternate banks between first & second 100's. On Sunday, the Doubles event will be shot as 2 sub-events of 25 pair each on two different traps and the following Handicap event will be shot as 4 sub-events of 25 targets each across all 4 traps.

Not every shooter who participates this weekend will leave here as a champion, but it is our sincere hope that all will be able to enjoy themselves, shoot to the best of their ability and leave satisfied.

A complete final listing of awards, added money and option monies will be mailed to all entrants.

2026 Northern Indiana Zone Championship Rules and Regulations

A shooter must be a resident of Indiana and of his or her zone for the six (6) months immediately preceding this tournament in order to be eligible for resident trophies or membership on the Zone 16 Yard and/or Doubles teams.

Classification for the 16 Yard & Doubles Events and determination of Handicap Yardage for the Championship Events will be taken from the shooter's 2025 and 2026 averages as shown on their 2026 Average Card or equivalent. Classes for High All-Around Awards will be based upon the shooter's 16 Yard Class in Saturday's Championship 16 Yard Event.

Shooters are required to have their Average Card or equivalent in their possession with averages correctly calculated and legibly displayed. It is the duty of each A.T.A. member to assure that all wins and ties in 16 yard and Doubles events are properly recorded on his or her Average Card. Shooters not having their Average Cards up to date may be classified at the discretion of the Handicap Committee (see A.T.A. Rules; Section IV, Article F).

PLEASE have your Average Card and plastic Membership Card ready when reporting for classification and/or squadding. Failure to do so will cause delays in the classification process not only for yourself but others as well.

- *A shooter must have shot 500 registered 16 Yard targets in the 2025 and 2026 target years **COMBINED** or will be advanced one class. Shooters with no registered targets are subject to penalty class "C" or higher, subject to known ability at the discretion of the Classification Committee.*
- *A shooter must have shot 500 registered Handicap targets in the 2025 and 2026 target years **COMBINED** or are subject to penalty yardage of current A.T.A. yardage plus two (2) yards, not to exceed 25 yards.*
- *A shooter must have shot 300 registered Doubles targets in the 2025 and 2026 target years **COMBINED** or will be advanced one class. Shooters with no registered targets are subject to penalty class "C" or higher, subject to known ability at the discretion of the Classification Committee.*

Target Requirements are waived for Senior Veterans and Lady II Shooters 70 years of age and older

All targets shot during "Preliminary Day" on Friday May 29th will count towards target requirements for Zone Championship Events. Classes in 16 yard and Doubles events may be determined by the Classification Committee using target year-to-date averages, the average on the last 1,000 targets or "known ability". Situations not specifically covered above are subject to applicable A.T.A. rules as interpreted and applied by the I.T.A. Zone Classification Committee.

Members of the I.T.A. Board of Directors or their designees shall be in charge of classification, shoot-offs and awarding of all trophies. They shall also certify the 16 Yard and Doubles Zone teams which shall consist of the high score in each class (AA-A-B-C-D), regardless of category in the 16 Yard Championships on Sat May 30th and Doubles Championships on Sun May 31st. First and second alternates shall be the second and third high scores in each class respectively. The zone teams will compete for the Zone Team Championship trophies during the 16 Yard Championship event on Saturday July 18th, 2026 and the Doubles Championship event on Sunday July 19th, 2026, respectively, at the 132nd Indiana State Trapshooting Championships to be held at Indiana Gun Club, located at 14926 E. 113th Street, Fishers, Indiana 46040.

Special Categories must be declared VERBALLY or must be clearly indicated on plastic ATA card at the time of Classification. It is **the responsibility of each individual shooter** (see A.T.A. Rules; Section IV, Article J) to verify his or her classification receipt and assure that such declaration is correctly noted. In case of an error, the shooter must notify the Tournament Office of the error before firing his/her first shot in an event. A shooter automatically regains his/her eligibility for SPECIAL CATEGORY trophies for all events he/she shoots their first target in AFTER the error has been reported and for SPECIAL CATEGORY High All-Around awards if the correction has been made prior to firing his/her first shot in the Handicap Event.

THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE

NORTHERN INDIANA ZONE CHAMPIONSHIPS
CLASS/YARDAGE GROUP vs. DECLARED SPECIAL CATEGORY

- Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and is tied for Event Champion in any Event **MAY** shoot-off for the Championship trophy. If the shooter fails in the Championship trophy shoot-off, he/she may fall back to the declared special category.
- Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score **DOES NOT** qualify for Event Champion or Champion in his/her declared category **IS** eligible to compete for class or yardage group.
- Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score **DOES NOT** qualify for Event Champion and **DOES** qualify for any trophy in his/her declared category will compete for the category trophy **ONLY** and is **NOT** eligible to compete for class or yardage group.

TROPHIES and OPTIONS ... PROGRAM NOTES

- All trophies and added monies listed are guaranteed and will be awarded regardless of the number of entrants (must be at least 1) in each Class, Yardage Group or Special Category.
- Ties for all trophies and added money will be shot off at the end of each day's events, respectively. An individual shooter may win only one trophy per event.
- Ties for 2nd and 3rd high scores in each class in the 16 Yard and Doubles Championship Events will be determined by long run from front, then if necessary, from back, and if still tied, by coin flip in order to determine the alternate and second alternate to represent the Northern Zone 16 Yard and Doubles Teams at the Indiana State Shoot.
- All other Options and Purses (including Special Event) will divide prize money equally between tied scores.
- Resident Handicap Champion is not eligible for Yardage Group added money or trophies.

All scores are final 15 minutes after the last squad is posted and will be forwarded to the A.T.A. as such. NO SCORES will be changed after that time. NO EXCEPTIONS.

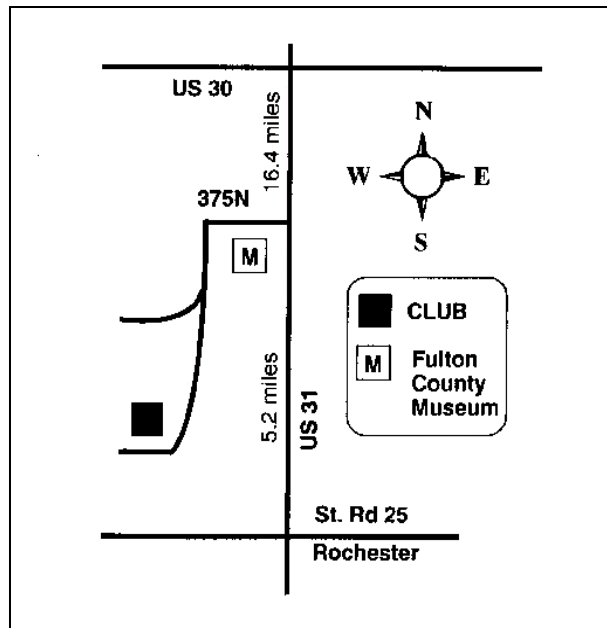
