He was followed by two 99s, three 97s, three 96s, three 95s, three 94s, five 93s, etc. Vets & Senior Vets dominated the makeup of shooters, 20 of 28 shooters.

Our very own Bill Mager rose to the top in the Handicap with a 97. That earned him a yard punch. Vets & Senior Vets dominated the field of shooters, 18 of 26 shooters.

Tom Antczak bested the field of Doubles shooters with a 96, followed by a 93, a 92, two 91s, etc.

We threw 6,600 targets. Total payouts amounted to \$500, including the Bounty.
