The ATA was founded in 1889 as the American Shooting Association. This was the first governing body for the sport of trapshooting. In 1923 the Amateur Trapshooting Association was born and it is now the



oldest and most recognized target shooting sports organization in the world. Throughout the years, this truly "American" sport has grown to become the largest clay target sport in the world.

ATA Becomes a Non-Profit

In support of a rich charitable and educational heritage the Association became an IRS approved and exempt non-profit organization under IRS section 501(c)(3) in 2004. This allows the Association to offer tax deductibility to contributors.

ENHANCING TODAY

Today, the ATA has a mission to promote and govern the sport of registered trapshooting throughout the world. Serving the individual members on a daily basis, the ATA also administers to the needs of over 1,200 ATA gun clubs that combine to host thousands of registered ATA shoots and throw millions of registered ATA targets annually.

Each year, the Association is host to the world championship tournament, the GRAND AMERICAN. The "GRAND" is the World's largest shooting tournament and attracts thousands each year. Held at the World Shooting and Recreational Complex in Sparta, Illinois, the venue is the largest trapshooting facility in the world with 120 trap fields. Spanning over 1,500 acres, 1,000 camping spaces are available plus sporting, skeet and cowboy action shooting facilities.

Youth Trapshooting

As the ATA has grown during the years, one of its largest and most successful efforts has been the development of the AIM (Academics, Integrity, Marksmanship) youth trapshooting program. Competitive youth statewide and zone wide events are administered during the year from the ATA national headquarters in Sparta, leading up to the AIM Grand National Championship event during the Grand American. In addition to program administration, the AIM program offers scholarship opportunities annually based upon the themes of the program – Academics, Integrity and Marksmanship.

The ATA is the world's premier trapshooting organization and is devoted to supporting all gun clubs while developing lifelong trapshooters and pro-gun advocates.


