

CERTIFICATION OF THE SHOOT:

This certifies that the MTA Gun Club of Linn Creek, Missouri, has been authorized to hold a Registered Shoot on September 21-27, 2020. ATA rules will govern this shoot and the scores will be included in the official records.

RULES GOVERNING THIS SHOOT:

- Contestants may shoot for targets only but will not be eligible for trophies, added money or allowed to enter options.
- 2. The management reserves the right to refuse the entry of, or to disqualify any shooter who in their opinion will interfere with the harmony of this shoot.
- 3. The club is not responsible in case of accident or theft.
- 4. Shooters will be responsible for checking their scores and notifying management of any discrepancies. For purses, options and trophies, all scores are final 30 minutes after completion of the event.
- 5. Scores will be posted on shootscoreboard.com each day.

FOOD WILL BE SERVED ON THE GROUNDS

Dogs must be on a leash & controlled at all times.

No pets allowed in the clubhouse

LAKE OF THE OZARKS FUN FACT

The Netflix original TV series, "Ozark," was created by Bill Dubuque, who chose to set the story in the Lake of the Ozarks because he'd worked there as a teenager and "had a deep love for the place." However, the Ozark scenes are shot in Atlanta, although they were modeled extensively after the Lake of the Ozarks.

There are over 70,000 homes at the Lake of the Ozarks. Similarly, there's just as many docks to match. And, of all the people who own two homes across the entire state of Missouri, 40% of them own one property on the Lake of the Ozarks.

SQUADDING

PRE-SQUADDING INFORMATION

Due to the Corona virus (COVID-19) we ask that you please help us eliminate the overcrowding of our club house and long lines by using www. presquad.com we have added this pre-pay form to our website https://www.cognitoforms.com/MTA9/_2020MissouriFallHandicap

This pre-pay form can only be used after you have pre-squadded. You will be able to cashier completely including all targets, fees and options. Pre-classification only, you can email Steve Ricketts at srickett@sbcglobal.net. By doing this it will help us abide by the "social distancing" regulations inside the club house and reduce long lines.

If you are not able to pre-squad and pre-pay we will be available Sunday, September 21 at 10 a.m. to classify, squad and accept entries. For this shoot to help eliminate cashiering lines we have eliminated the no refund policy for both pre-squad and walk-in entries.

The MTA will offer pre-squadding for this shoot using the Internet website **www.presquad.com**. This is a very easy system to use which lets you pick your own squads. You can return to the website anytime to look over the pre-squadded shooters. Pre-squadding will start August 23, 2020 and end on September 14, 2020. To help reduce empty posts, all Pre-squad posts not paid the day before will be opened up at 8 a.m. the next morning.

50 TARGETS PER FIELD

All events will be shot 50 targets per field. Banks are numbered from west to east. The numbers on the trap houses will not change for the duration of this shoot.

RELOCATION OF SQUADS

Please note that squad hustlers have the authority to move squads to different nearby traps at any time. This will be done in an effort to expedite the progress of events.

SHOOTERS MUST SQUAD RESPONSIBLY

Every attempt will be made to fill handicap squads. Squadding at one position in handicap events, and then actually shooting at a different position for squad can create yardage conflicts on the firing line. When squadding or returning unused posts, please remember that your actions have an impact on other shooters, in addition to yourself.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Classification, Cashiering & Squadding Monday through Sunday, September 21-27, 8 a.m. Sunday, September 27, 8 a.m. - Last Flight

Practice Traps open September 21-27, 8 a.m.

2020 Attendance pins will be given to all shooters.

MISSING SQUAD PENALTY: Any shooter missing their squad and desiring to re-enter the event shall pay a \$10 penalty.

MAKE-UPS: A maximum of 50 targets can be made up per event. If you miss your squad for more than 50 targets, you must be re-squadded. Please see cashiering for exceptions and make-up sheets.

CARRY-OVERS: Ties for trophies in Singles and Doubles events will be carried over by sub-event to the next like event. Unless specified otherwise, shoot-offs will be for trophies only and will be combined if possible. Handicap ties will be determined daily.

TROPHIES: ATA rules will be used to determine winners of ALL TROPHIES regardless of who furnishes the trophies. ATA rules regarding "fall backs" will be used to determine ALL winners.

Shoot-Offs: Shooters will be called 3 times for shoot-offs. A shooter who fails to appear will forfeit. If no shoot-off contestants appear, a winner will be determined by management. Shooters may sign up for shoot off text alerts during the shoot. It will still be necessary to check in after first call has been made by shoot management. Sub-Juniors, Juniors & Junior Gold: Entry fee is \$32 per 100. Eligible for all option and added money—must have 500 registered targets in each discipline or shoot penalty yardage or class.

ATA RULES: The Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern all points not otherwise provided.

SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS: All Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Juniors, Juniors, Junior Gold, Sub-Veterans, Veterans and Senior Veterans desiring to compete for trophies in these categories must properly declare their category at time of classification. Without such declaration, the shooter will not be allowed to compete for applicable special category trophies. A shooter eligible for a special category designation is not required to declare a special category. It is the shooter's responsibility to verify proper classification before leaving the classification desk. The declaration is binding for the duration of the shoot. A shooter desiring to obtain All American points for a special category must be classified in the special category. If you declare your category you will be entitled to the added money in that event in conjunction with your score (money goes with the score). You will still be able to take championship or category trophies. You will be able to shoot for added money.

PAYOUTS: Payouts will be available after 12 noon the day following the event. Sunday's payouts will be mailed.

ENTRY

Your entry will not be considered made until you have paid. Personal checks will be accepted in U.S. funds only for the amount of entries. There will be a \$30 charge for any returned check. There will be a \$15 surcharge on each check written on a non-U.S. Bank. A shooter who has already cashiered for an event may not later enter the purses & options after that event has been called to the line. All shooters wishing to play any option must provide their Social Security number when classified. There are no compulsory options in any event.

Visa/Mastercard/Discover & American Express accepted for entries, RV spaces, etc.

RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES

The Missouri Trapshooters Association reserves the right to postpone or call off any event in this tournament and to change the time for the starting of any or all events, if in the judgment of the Shoot Management such action is necessary. In the case entries are so numerous that darkness or any other cause prevents the finish of any event the same day it is commenced, the Shoot Management reserves the right to stop shooting at any time it is deemed necessary. In this case, weather permitting, events will resume where left off at 8 a.m. the next day.

WHEN A SQUAD IS UP

A squad will not be held up for a tardy member. If the tardy shooter does not appear, IN THREE MINUTES, the shooter will be scratched and may be re-squadded in a later squad, subject to re-squadding penalty or allowed to make-up up to a maximum of 50 targets.

ATTENTION SHOOTERS

- 1. Daily Fees: ATA \$3, MTA Target Fee \$3 per 100
- All guns must be unloaded with the action open at all times, except on the firing line.
- 3. ATA ruling on alcoholic beverages and drugs will be enforced.
- 4. The management reserves the right to refuse entry or disqualify anyone who interferes with the harmony of the shoot.

LAKE OF THE OZARKS FUN FACT

The Lake of the Ozarks actually has more coastline than the entire state of California, with 1,100 miles of shoreline. Most people don't realize the expansiveness of the lake, but are quickly surprised when they visit.





CLASSIFICATION

All shooters MUST have their plastic ATA card and a complete list of their 16-yard and doubles scores and average up to date. Classification will be based on average and known ability. Shooters must shoot Class B or higher if they have shot less than 500 registered 16-yard targets or at 23-yard handicap (minimum) if they have shot less than 500 handicap targets in the 2019 & 2020 target years. Shooters must shoot Class B or higher if they have shot less than 500 registered doubles in the 2019 & 2020 target years. Senior Veteran are exempt from penalties.

Winners and ties will advance one class.

The ATA rules will govern all points not otherwise provided. If you win your class in any event or earn yardage in any Handicap, it is your responsibility to report such to the classification committee. Winners and ties move up in class starting with Event 7. In all events that include class advances all shooters (regardless of category) with scores that equal or exceed the score of the class champion will be advanced starting with the next like event. A shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason shall be considered notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin board.

YOUTH BENEFIT SILENT AUCTION & YOUTH LEWIS OPTIONS

A silent auction to benefit Missouri's youth trapshooters will be held in the clubhouse during the shoot. A variety of youth trapshooting activities benefit from this auction, including the youth scholarship program, youth teams representing Missouri at the Grand American and the Annual High School Championship in April. Bidding will end Saturday eventing.

The Youth Lewis Option is offered in many events and are a continued source of funds for Missouri's youth shooters. One half of all entry fees in this option are used to help fund youth trapshooting programs, and the other half is paid back to winners.



RV HOOKUPS

Accommodations for 329 trailers with electric and water hookups is \$225 for entire shoot; \$40 per night if by the day. Dry camping is \$100. Advanced reservations are required. Please call first to be put on the RV list. Availability is accepted by request date and must be confirmed by Management. Do not send money until confirmed spot is acknowledged. A dump station is located on the grounds. Showers and restrooms are open 24 hours during the shoot. Commercial space with electricity is \$200 for 20-foot space. All awnings, stakes, tables and signs must be kept behind the electrical post. Advance reservations accepted upon receipt of \$200. No additional fee for living quarters.

GOLF CART - ATV REQUIREMENTS

Before operating a golf cart/ATV on the grounds you must obtain a permit from the MTA office which will be available at no cost. To obtain a permit you must produce a valid driver's license and proof of \$300,000 "off premises" liability insurance coverage on privately owned carts or ATVs. NO ONE MAY OPERATE A CART UNLESS THEY POSSESS A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE. Your cooperation in these rules will help maintain safety and will be greatly appreciated.

GOLF CART RENTALS

Golf carts will only be available for rental with ADVANCE RESERVATIONS and deposit. Call the MTA office 573-346-2449 for further details and to make your reservations prior to September 15.

SHELLS

Shells will be for sale on the grounds by Graf & Sons Mexico, MO. No other shell sales permitted on grounds. If you wish to save your hulls for reloading, please transfer them from your gun to your pocket or box. Picking up hulls will not be tolerated at any time, WE ENCOURAGE YOU NOT TO DROP SHELLS ON THE GROUND TO ASSIST OUR SCORERS, All shells must conform to ATA specifications. Shoot Management reserves the right to inspect any shells. Any loads that disturb the harmony of the Shoot will be investigated; and, if necessary, the shooter will be re-squadded or disqualified.

PRACTICE ROUNDS



FORD PURSES

The winner of each sub-event and the total will receive the \$2 entry fees. Ford purses will be decided by reverse score system where a winner has not been determined, Total will divide. Any shooter winning one of the first four Ford purses will not be eligible to win another except total.




