1 Introduction

This is an open competition and is intended to provide an opportunity for interested Para Trap athletes to achieve the Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) required to participate in the World Shooting Para Sport (WSPS) 2019 World Championships in Sydney, Australia.

<u>Athlete participation at the WSPS 2019 World Championships, while</u> sanctioned by USA Shooting, is strictly self-funded.

2 Organization and Administration

USA Shooting will organize and administer this competition as per WSPS guidelines. This competition is being scheduled concurrent with USA Shooting's Shotgun National Championships.

3 Dates of Competition

7/13/2019	Pre-Event Training - 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
7/14/2019	Para Trap 75 targets – Start time 9:00 a.m.
7/15/2019	Para Trap 50 targets + Final + Awards – Start time 9:00 a.m.

4 Venue

USA Shooting will conduct this competition on Field #3 at the International Shooting Park. This trap field is equipped with concrete sidewalks from the parking lot to the firing line.

6 Eligibility/Classification

Please refer to the World Shooting Para Sport website <u>www.paralympic.org/shooting</u> for more information about classifications.

The WSPS current classification system is under a two year review period (September 2017 - September 2019). There are 3 different classes/events that athletes are eligible to compete in. They are:

Event <u>PT1</u>, Class SG-S: Athletes with poor balance and/or trunk stability, competing from a wheelchair in a standard seated position. Athletes have an impairment in the lower limb(s), but no functional limitation in the upper limbs.

Event <u>PT2</u>, Class SG-L: Athletes with good balance and trunk function, competing from a standing position. Athletes have an impairment in the lower limb(s), but no functional limitation in the upper limbs.

Event <u>PT3</u>, Class SG-U: Athletes with good balance and trunk function, competing from a standing position. Athletes have an impairment in the non-shooting arm.

9 Registration and Fees

- 1. All competitors must be current members of USA Shooting.
- The USA Shooting classification system will be used. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm their age and classification upon check in. If you do not state your classification and/or category correctly you will not be eligible for that particular award. There will be no changes after competitor check-in and awards will not be redistributed.
- 3. Competitors must check in, verify their entry information and pick up their competitor number in person or be represented by their team official.
