PROPOSED ALL AMERICAN POINTS PROCEDURES RULEBOOK REVISIONS

ATA STATE/PROVINCIAL TOURNAMENTS & THE US OPEN - Events eligible for points as follows: All championship events, including High All Around and High Over All; plus preliminary events during the last five, seven days for a maximum of 1,300 targets in both the preliminary events and the championship events.

Any preliminary event with 450 or more entries (except for team races) shall also be an All American points event.

In those events where only open (residency) trophies are awarded, points will be earned based on a shooter's score without regard to the shooter's residency. In events where any combination of resident, open (residency), or non-resident trophies are awarded, points will be earned based on a shooter's residency.

Table 3 Points - All Preliminary events the last five, seven days to a maximum of the final 1,300 targets.

OTHER MAJOR TOURNAMENT An "Other Major tournament" is defined as any tournament with a combined entry in the Singles, Handicap and Doubles Championship of 450 and over.

Events eligible for points are as follows:

All championship events, including High All Around and High Over All. If the championship events combined entry is 450 or over, preliminary events during the last five, seven days for a maximum of 1,300 targets in both the preliminary events and the championship events will also be eligible for All American points.

Any preliminary event with 450 or more entries (except for team races) shall also be an All-American points event.

The same named tournament and location will be guaranteed points at least equal to that achieved (depending on attendance) the following year.
